Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and

stereotypes that are not consistent with the current values and practices at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Biographical History

Jean Stone Willans (b. October 3, 1924 – d. April 1, 2020) was a primary catalyst of the Charismatic Renewal. After experiencing the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, she was a vital participant in the historic events at her home church, St. Marks Episcopal, Van Nuys, CA. Her subsequent pilgrimage contributed to the transformation of twentieth-century Christianity. The Blessed Trinity Society was organized in 1960 to promote the renewal. It served as the supporting institution that brought Jean Stone to hundreds of churches, colleges, universities and auditoriums in the U.S.A., Canada, Mexico and Great Britain. From 1961-1965, she edited *Trinity*, an influential magazine “dedicated to maintaining the ‘fullness of the faith.’” The magazine spurred the early growth of the movement and coined the term “charismatic renewal.”

Rick Willans (b. July 24, 1943 – d. December 10, 2020) grew up in Detroit and worshipped at a local Pentecostal Church and at Brightmoor Tabernacle, a large Assembly of God Church. While in his youth, when his father, a successful lawyer, received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues, Rick and his mother followed suit that same morning. In 1964, Rick went to California to work for *Trinity* where he met Jean.

Called to Asia in 1967, the Willanses ministered in Indonesia and Taiwan before settling in Hong Kong (1968-1984). The couple founded the Society of Stephen, which became a primary regional fountainhead of the Charismatic Renewal, particularly among Roman Catholics. They also pioneered, along with Jackie Pullinger, a ministry to drug addicts that drew international media attention due to the consistent pattern of painless withdrawal (without medication) through faith in Jesus and prayer in tongues. Since 1984, the Willanses continued their ministry based in Altadena, California. The city of Kowoon commemorated their efforts with the construction of the Kowoon Memorial. The couple continued a close correspondence with their daughter Suzy Jagger and her family in Great Britain.

Professionally, Rick built on his three-year Bachelor of Arts degree studies at Dartmouth College to successfully graduate from the University of San Francisco. During his working life, he held responsible positions in recruiting and human resources management in the United States and South East Asia. He started as a sales consultant with West Coast Carpet Corporation, Los Angeles; recruiter with RCM Services Ltd, a small but well-known firm in Hong Kong; Partner, Director-Executive Selection, Peat, Marwick, Mitchell & Co. Hong Kong; Assistant Vice President, Personnel Director, General Bank, Los Angeles; and Vice President of Human Resources, Union Bank of California.

Scope and Content

The Jean Stone Willans and Richard J. Willans Collection records span from 1961-2004, with some earlier documents from the Willans' family histories. The collection documents the history of Jean Stone and Rick Willans' leadership in the charismatic renewal movement, including the movement's initial organization and publication, both initiated by Jean. The collection's core is the complete run of the Willans' newsletters while on mission in Indonesia and Hong Kong from 1967-1984. A large portion of correspondence, photos, documents, and mementos supplement the newsletters. Overall, the collection contains correspondence, published and unpublished manuscripts, photographs, music texts, memorabilia, scrapbooks, and audio-visual materials.

Series Description

Series I: Blessed Trinity Society, 1961-1967 (Boxes 1-3)

Series I documents the Blessed Trinity Society's development and history from 1960 through the Willans' departure in 1967. The section includes a copy of Jean Stone's history of the BTS. Supplemental research records consist of meeting minutes; photos of early gatherings; a leaflet from the anniversary celebration; notes for a song; and missionary certificates.

There are a number of pamphlets, leaflets and notices published by the Blessed Trinity Society, as well as the complete run of *Trinity Magazine*. The section also includes testimonies written by people influenced by the Blessed Trinity Society's efforts.

There are clippings and notes regarding friends involved in the fledgling charismatic renewal movement including Armin Gesswein, Jean Darnall, Madeleine Duncan, Bob Whitaker, and the Reverend Harold James Smith of Pisgah. Newspaper clippings include Jean's handwritten notes regarding her personal contact with individuals mentioned in the articles. See also Du Plessis collection, "Episcopalians Filled with the Spirit," Pentecost, Mar 1962.

There is also a folder of letters and articles related to the controversy caused by the charismatic renewal. Of additional interest are records from the 25th anniversary of the charismatic renewal celebration at Pisgah.

Series II: Correspondence, A-Z (Boxes 4-6)

Series II includes correspondence and address books, spanning the Willans' lifetimes. The letters are arranged alphabetically by the correspondent's last name. The section does not include family letters or cards.

Series III: Personal History (Box 7)

Series III is a collection of personal photos, documents and mementos. Formats consists of photograph albums, diplomas, certificates of achievement, and family history documents. It also includes cards and photos from the 1958 Fashion Tea, Jean Stone Willans' ministry at St. Mark's Episcopal prior to the charismatic renewal efforts. Rick Willans' published and unpublished articles and poems are present.

Series IV: Indonesia and Hong Kong, 1967-1984 (Boxes 8-14)

Series IV represents the core of the collection with records from Willans' ministries in Indonesia and Hong Kong. There is a written history of the Society of Stephen, clippings, photos, publications, documents, and photos of the Kowloon Monument. The Kowloon Monument memorializes the Willans' contribution to the city. Testimonies describe individuals healed from drug addiction through the Willans' ministry and the Society of Stephen, and became members of the households and the church they founded. Many photographs and large photo albums have names and comments written on the back.

The section includes manuscripts and working notes for the Chinese translation of the Willans' autobiographical work, *The Acts of the Green Apples*. The newsletters are a collection of handwritten letters to friends and ministry supporters. Topics cover full of news of the ministry, life updates, and local information.

Series V: Altadena, 1984-2004 (Box 15)

Series V spans the period of the Willans' return to the United States to the early 2000s. The Kowloon Memorial file is in Series IV. The section includes documents related to the continuing ministries of the Society and Jackie Pullinger. Other records consist of correspondence, photos, notes, and holiday cards. Celebrated events include Jean Willan's consecration as Bishop of California in the Hebrew Church of the East and the opening celebration of the archival

collection at Fuller Theological Seminary. There are also copies of newsletters and articles such as copies of biographical articles on Jean Stone and/or Rick Willans from *Who's Who*; *Contemporary Authors*; and the *International Register*; and *Who's Who in America* entries. A set of the *Messiah Letter*, newsletters by friends Floyd and Clarisse Newman, are present.

Series VI: Suzy Jagger and husband Hugh Jagger (Box 16)

Series VI includes letters from the Willans' daughter Suzy Jagger, her husband Hugh Jagger their children to the Willanses. The letters document the continuing influence of the charismatic renewal in the Jagger's lives and their participation in it as well as the warm relationship between the families. The series also includes the Jaggers' mementos, letters from friends, and photos.

Series VII: Publications, Manuscripts, Drafts (Boxes 17-19)

Series VII includes drafts, notes, manuscripts, and published versions of pamphlets, songbooks and books. The documents were written during the Hong Kong period and later. It includes the Willans' autobiographical work, *The Acts of the Green Apples*. The Society of Stephen and its participants, including Jackie Pullinger, Geoff Craighead, Jack Chinn and Michael Harper, wrote other publications found in this section. The Society of Stephen reissued Harper's book, *As at the Beginning*.

Series IV: Indonesia and Hong Kong, 1967-1984. Boxes 8-14.

Series Scope and Content Note

Series IV represents the core of the collection with records from Willans' ministries in Indonesia and Hong Kong. There is a written history of the Society of Stephen, clippings, photos, publications, documents, and photos of the Kowloon Monument. The Kowloon Monument memorializes the Willans' contribution to the city. Testimonies describe individuals healed from drug addiction through the Willans' ministry and the Society of Stephen, and became members of the households and the church they founded. Many photographs and large photo albums have names and comments written on the back.

The section includes manuscripts and working notes for the Chinese translation of the Willans' autobiographical work, *The Acts of the Green Apples*. The newsletters are a collection of handwritten letters to friends and ministry supporters. Topics cover full of news of the ministry, life updates, and local information.
