## Biographical History

Joseph Mattsson-Bozé (b. February 7, 1955 – d. January 22, 1989) was a Swedish-American minister who became a leader in the "Latter Rain" movement during the 1940s-1950s. In 1933, at the behest of the Philadelphia Church in Gothenburg, Sweden, Joseph Mattsson-Bozé (1905-1989) immigrated to Chicago, Illinois, to serve as pastor to a growing congregation of Swedish immigrants. Two years later, he traveled back to Sweden, married Daga Adolphina Erlandson, and returned to Chicago with his bride. For 18 of the next 22 years, Mattsson-Bozé served as pastor to Chicago's Philadelphia Church. He took a hiatus from 1939-1943 during which he pastored the Rock Church in New York.

When he resigned as pastor in 1958, Mattsson-Bozé launched the Herald of Faith (Independent Pentecostal) mission to East Africa and, later, Argentina. During his years as a pastor and for 13 years as a missionary, Mattsson-Bozé also edited the *Herald of Faith* journal. He figured prominently in the Independent Pentecostal Fellowship and had strong ties to William Branham's ministry. Among Mattsson-Bozé's Swedish publications are three books entitled *Äventyr på trons Väg*; *Gyllene Tempel och Gyllene Tillfällen*; and *Tro som Förflyttar Berg*.

Letters written during Mattsson-Bozé's tenure as pastor range in topic from the everyday problems faced by the pastor of a strongly immigrant congregation to detailed opinions on church organization and doctrine. They also include letters to and from the mission fields written in the early 1940s. While pastor of Rock Church, Mattsson-Bozé helped carry the burden of financing independent missionaries during the war. The correspondence from these years, contrasts the dire economic and physical struggles faced by missionaries. The letters were written in English, Swedish, and an English-Swedish patois.

Mattsson-Bozé's letters written as an Executive Committee member at the First World Pentecostal Conference address the organization's composition and doctrinal differences. They also reflect Mattsson-Bozé's hopes and concerns for the Pentecostal fellowship worldwide at during the mid-20<sup>th</sup> century. One of Mattsson-Bozé's highlights from the conference was the agreement he co-authored with David du Plessis that allowed "independents," including Lewi Pethrus and the Swedish churches, to cooperate with the Pentecostal movement. Du Plessis and Mattsson-Bozé's friendship lasted the rest of their lives. Upon the establishment of the David Du Plessis Archive, Du Plessis requested Mattsson-Bozé's papers be housed with his. The Mattsson-Bozé papers stand as a rich resource, too, for studies of William Branham, another close friend of Mattsson-Bozé's, about whom Mattsson-Bozé published monthly articles from 1955 until Branham's death in 1965.

*Herald of Faith* was an English version, which succeeded the Swedish publications *Sanningens Vittnen* and *Trons Härold*. *Trons Härold* was first published in the 1930s. The *Herald of Faith* served as a fellowship magazine for the Independent Assemblies of God until about 1958. In 1952, the journal merged with *Faith Journal* and in 1969 with *Harvest Time*.

In 1972, the journal from transitioned Mattsson-Bozé's to Dan Malachuk of Logos International. Malachuk renamed it *Logos Journal*. For much of the 1930s, the journal was published in Duluth, MN. Sometime before 1942, the place of publication changed to 5437 North Clark Street, Chicago, IL. From 1939-1942, editing responsibilities for the journal were shared with A.J.

Rasmussen. At the time, Rasmussen served as Pastor to the Philadelphia Church, while Mattsson-Bozé led the Rock Church in New York. When Mattsson-Bozé left the Rock Church, he took the publication with him.

The publication was one of many unofficial organs of the independent Pentecostal churches in the United States. The journal featured articles on church organization, doctrine, and letters from missionaries. It also carried advertisements for healing conventions and itinerant evangelists. The *Herald of Faith* frequently contained reprints of articles from other Christian - usually Pentecostal - magazines and newspapers. The publication promoted a model of church government patterned on the one developed by Lewi Pethrus for the Swedish Filadelfia Church, which stressed group leadership through elders.

Much of its distinct appeal and popularity, however, can be traced to William Branham's prophetic visions, which were featured regularly. Traveling evangelists and local church members, recipients of a small commission, disseminated the magazine and collected subscriptions for the magazine. The journal's focus changed when Mattsson-Bozé left Philadelphia Church to minister in East Africa.

Papers related to the publication of the *Herald of Faith* include materials from Mattsson-Bozé's missionary campaigns – primarily photographs, newsletters, and memorabilia. These papers, along with his correspondence from that time, loosely trace the development of the East African Revival mission.

Mattsson-Bozé's letters document project management challenges regarding the journal's publication. Journal issues usually came out monthly. Occasionally, issues were combined due to lack of finances or publishing material. For example, in 1951 and 1952 certain numbers of *Herald of Faith* and *Sanningens Vittne Trons Härold* were published together along with the regular Herald Faith numbers. Minor idiosyncrasies in publication include a volume change in 1954 when volume 19 (9), September, is followed by volume 21 (10), October, and a missing volume, 28, which should have come out in 1961.

## Scope and Content

Joseph Mattsson-Bozé became a leader in the "Latter Rain" movement, a splinter movement within Pentecostalism in the 1940s and 1950s. His papers range in date from 1933 to the early 1970s. It includes correspondence with significant figures in classical independent Pentecostal circles. A full run of the Swedish journal *Trons Härold*, which became the English-language journal *Herald of Faith*, can be found in the collection. These papers, along with the DeGregorio Papers, constitute a rich resource for independent or nondenominational Pentecostalism.

The collection includes material on: Immigrant Churches; Latter Rain; Independent Pentecostal Churches; East African Revival; Revival in Argentina; Rock Church (New York, NY); Philadelphia Church (Chicago, IL); First World Pentecostal Conference (1949); William Branham; Henry Carlson; and Clair Hutchens.

The current arrangement of the materials is the work of Martha Nelson, Joseph Mattsson-Bozé's longtime secretary.

## Series Description

Series I: Sermons, Tracts, Clippings, Periodicals, (Boxes 1-2)

The series includes a handful of typed sermons composed by Mattsson-Bozé and Lewi Pethrus. Various tracts and reprints related primarily to the Latter Rain and doctrinal issues important to the independent assemblies are located in the collection. There is also a small collection of *Spoken Word* reprints of William Branham's sermons.

The section features a substantial collection of journals that Mattsson-Bozé edited: *Herald of Faith*, *Trons Härold*; and *Sanningens Vittne*. A group of *Conviction periodicals* is present.

Series II: Correspondence (Boxes 3-24)

The correspondence is arranged chronologically, and then by author's last name. The majority of the correspondence covers the period from 1938-1958, with occasional correspondence from earlier and later years. Approximately three-fourths of the letters are in English with the remainder in Swedish. Themes found among the letters include independent Pentecostal church organization; the Latter Rain Movement; mission fields; independent ministers; and daily church operations. Mattsson-Bozé's correspondence details his different roles: preacher, editor, theologian, public relations man, fundraiser, businessperson, immigrant sponsor, and missionary.

Almost all of the photographs pertain to the latter years of Mattsson-Bozé's *Herald of Faith* magazine (1933-1970) and the Herald of Faith Ministry begun in 1959. They mostly depict East Africa. Other images feature the United States and Sweden.
