Biographical History

Daniel Payton Fuller (August 28, 1928 – June 21, 2023), a theologian and professor of hermeneutics, was Dean of the Faculty at Fuller Theological Seminary and Dean of its Graduate School of Theology. His best-known work, *The Unity of the Bible: Unfolding God's Plan for Humanity* (1992), emphasizes the continuity between Old Covenant and New Covenant economies, and the central place of Christ's redemptive work in God's plan for humankind.

Fuller was born in Los Angeles, California, the only child of Charles Edward Fuller and Grace Payton Fuller. At the time, his father was the pastor of Calvary Church in Placentia, California. Charles Fuller was a pioneer radio evangelist; founder and director of the *Old Fashioned Revival Hour (OFRH)* radio program; and co-founder of Fuller Theological Seminary (FTS). The Seminary, founded in 1947, was named in honor of Henry Fuller, Dan Fuller's paternal grandfather.

After graduation from South Pasadena High school in 1943, Dan Fuller enlisted in the U. S. Navy and began the officer-training program at Occidental College, Los Angeles. Eight months later, he was transferred to the University of California at Berkeley to train in the Naval ROTC. In 1944, Fuller graduated from the University of California and was commissioned as an ensign in the U. S. Navy. He served for fifteen months before being discharged in August 1946. After discharge, Fuller entered Princeton Theological Seminary. He was ordained to the Christian ministry at Immanuel Baptist Church of Pasadena, California and served as Assistant Pastor of the Park Street Church in Boston, Massachusetts from 1949 to 1950.

In 1950, Fuller resumed theological studies at FTS, enrolling in the Seminary's second graduating class. Dr. Wilbur M. Smith, a founding faculty member, inspired him with a new interest in English Bible. Fuller graduated with a Bachelor of Divinity in 1951 and a Th. M. in 1952.

For the next several years, Fuller continued his academic education while balancing teaching responsibilities. In the academic year 1953-1954, Fuller did residence work toward a Th. D. at Northern Baptist Theological Seminary, Chicago. He eventually received his Th. D. in 1957. In this season, he taught at FTS from 1954 to 1959 with a brief position as a teaching assistant in English Bible in 1953. In 1957, Fuller became an assistant professor of English Bible. In 1959, he moved with his wife Ruth (Ph. D. in Biblical Studies) and four children to Basel, Switzerland. He commenced studies under Drs. Bo Reicke, Oscar Cullmann, and Karl Barth. Fuller received a D. Theol. degree in 1966 from the University of Basel, Switzerland.

Returning to California in late 1962, Fuller was appointed as Dean of the Faculty at FTS. When the Seminary's academic administration added the Graduate School of World Mission and the Graduate School of Psychology, the Dean of the Faculty responsibilities transitioned to

individual deanships for each graduate school. Fuller became the Dean of the Graduate School of Theology. Fuller served as Associate Professor of Hermeneutics from 1963 to 1972. In 1972, he left the Dean's office and returned to full-time teaching as Professor of Hermeneutics. Fuller became the Senior Professor of Hermeneutics on September 1, 1993 and retired from full-time teaching at the age of 68. Fuller was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Divinity degree in 1993.

From 1946 until Charles Fuller's death in 1968, Daniel Fuller supported his father's radio ministry work in various capacities. Occasionally, he spoke as the substitute preacher on the *OFRH*. He also continued as the program's interim speaker after 1968, until David Allan Hubbard assumed the role regularly under the program's new title, *Joyful Sound*. In the 1950s, Fuller worked for a year in producing 'The Old Fashioned Meeting,' the short-lived television counterpart to the radio broadcast. Fuller served as the Assistant Director of the Gospel Broadcasting Association, the managing entity of the *OFRH* radio program. Fuller was appointed as president of the Fuller Evangelistic Association in 1968. The Fuller Evangelistic Association (formerly Fuller Evangelistic Foundation), managed the finances for the *OFRH* and supported other evangelistic Christian ministries. Later, he prioritized his passion for scholastic research, and transitioned away from FEA to focus on teaching and scholarship.

Recognizing his role as a custodian of his father's legacy, Daniel Fuller provided leadership within the Fuller Evangelistic Association and Fuller Theological Seminary's Board of Trustees. Daniel Fuller also utilized his skills as a historian by authoring his father's biography, *Give the Winds A Mighty Voice: The Story of Charles E. Fuller* (1972). In many ways, Fuller also became the Seminary's *de facto* historian from the school's inception in 1947 until his death in 2023.

In addition to several years' experience in various kinds of church work, Fuller also engaged in collegiate evangelism with Campus Crusade for Christ. Dan Fuller was the editor of *Today's Christian*, a monthly paper sent out to supporters of the radio broadcast *The Joyful Sound* from 1972 to 1980. He wrote two columns each month: "Highlights in the Life of Charles E. Fuller," and a devotional piece entitled "I was Just Thinking." In 1996, he started a website, "The Berean Corner," on classical inductive Bible study and biblical theology as a resource for ministers.

Dan Fuller authored four books, *The Unity of the Bible* (1992, Zondervan); *Gospel and Law: Contrast or Continuum?* (1980, Eerdmans); *Give the Winds a Mighty Voice: The Life of Charles E. Fuller* (1972, Word); and *Easter Faith and History* (1965, Eerdmans). Fuller's articles have appeared in numerous theological journals, including the *Scottish Journal of Theology*, *Theologische Zeitschrift*, *The Journal of the American Academy of Religion*, *The Christian Scholar's Review*, *The Westminster Theological Journal*, and the *Journal of the Evangelical Theological Society*. His 14,500-word article on hermeneutics appears in the *International Standard Bible Encyclopedia*, Vol. 2, Eerdmans, 1982. Three of his articles have also appeared in festschriften in honor of George Eldon Ladd, Everett F. Harrison and David Allan Hubbard.

Scope and Content

The Papers of Daniel Payton Fuller, 1928-2000 document the life and ministry of Daniel Payton Fuller, a theologian and professor of hermeneutics. The collection includes personal family background materials, and documents Dan Fuller's education and work as Faculty member and Dean at Fuller Seminary. The bulk of the collection's materials is dated between 1946 and 1996. The collection also includes papers related to his work as Assistant Director of the Gospel Broadcasting Association and as President of the Fuller Evangelistic Association.

Records include Dr. Dan Fuller's course materials, sermons, correspondence, writings, Fuller Seminary administrative papers, biographical documents, photos, and clippings, and a small collection of audio tapes related to his ministry.

This series includes Dan Fuller's personal correspondence from 1960-1996. The correspondents include H. J. Ockenga, John Piper, Thomas Torrance, Ted Dorman, and Oscar Cullmann.

This section includes correspondence with the World Council of Churches. There are also publication materials a small collection of personal books, memory verse cards, and retirement accounts.

Series X: Audio tapes, books, and ephemera (Boxes 38-43, 45-49)

This section includes audio-visual records, Fuller Seminary ephemera, and history notes. There are *The Unity of the Bible* audiocassettes, Daniel Fuller's retirement album, and 60th birthday album of letters of congratulation. Additions to the collection were added in this series.
