Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and

Biographical History

Lucille Elene Swank was born November 22, 1922, in Ontario, California. Her parents, Evelena and Charley Swank, met at the Azusa Street Mission in Los Angeles, California, where they served in the orchestra. Evelena's father, Sam Smith, began attending the Azusa Street Mission in 1912 or 1913. When Ms. Swank was nine years old, the family attended a Pentecostal revival. As she came forward during an altar call, she began speaking in tongues. She went to her father, who also began speaking in tongues. She remembered that 35 other young people followed her lead and came to the altar as well.

Lee Roy Erickson was born in Provencal, Louisiana, July 8, 1917. Mr. Erickson left Louisiana after high school. He stayed with his married sister in California to receive training at a vocational institute. In 1939, Mr. Erickson hitchhiked to St. Paul, Minnesota, to attend Apostolic Bible Institute (ABI). After one year, he returned to California to work for Douglas Aircraft. In California, he met his evangelist-sister's best friend, Lucille. Because it was wartime, they married within three months, on February 1, 1942. Mr. Erickson did not serve abroad during the war; his job at Douglas was valuable to the war effort. He worked for Northwest Airlines for 35 years.

In 1952, Mr. Erickson spent a year and a half attending ABI. The family returned to Ontario, California, where Mr. Erickson resumed his work and supported the United Pentecostal Church (UPC). Mr. Erickson served as Sunday School Superintendent and a teacher for the UPC. Mrs. Erickson served as bookkeeper for 17 years; and as a piano player, teacher, and Ladies Auxiliary director for the Southern California region. During one of Mr. Erickson's sabbaticals, his family helped him to start a new church in Yucaipa, California.

Mr. Erickson kept his goal to complete his studies at ABI. Over the next ten years, the Erickson family enjoyed ABI and Midway Tabernacle, its associated church. When their oldest daughter enrolled in 1962, the family moved to St. Paul, Minn. Mr. Erickson enrolled at ABI and graduated in 1964. Mrs. Erickson served as director of the ABI Wives group. Inspired by vacations in Hawaii, she organized luaus as fundraisers in the Apostolic Bible Church. People fondly recalled the mountains of fudge her ABI Wives group made and sold, neatly wrapped in cellophane with a holly sprig in the middle.

Mr. and Mrs. Erickson supported missionaries, visiting many of them with gifts and encouragement. Mrs. Erickson was a gifted cake decorator and once traveled to Bogota, Colombia to make a wedding cake for the son of her long-time missionary friend. An orphanage in Nigeria was dedicated in honor of the Ericksons' generosity. Oneness Pentecostalism was Mr. Erickson's great passion. He loved to read the Bible and engage in conversations and arguments defending it. In 2002, the Ericksons celebrated their 60th anniversary. Mrs. Erickson died two months later. Up to his final days, Mr. Erickson always had a new joke, knew current events, and quoted scripture flawlessly. The couple raised four children, all Pentecostals.

Scope and Content

The Lee Roy and Lucille Erickson Collection contains published and unpublished materials collected by Lee Roy and Lucille Erickson. Most materials relate to their involvement with: the Western District of the United Pentecostal Church; Apostolic Bible Church, St. Paul, Minnesota; and Apostolic Bible Institute, St. Paul, Minnesota. The collection includes numerous books, tracts, periodicals, and audio and video recordings.

The collection primarily documents Oneness Pentecostalism, a growing and poorly understood segment of the Pentecostal movement. Of particular import are materials relating to Apostolic Bible Church and its pastor, Robert A. Sabin. Apostolic Bible Church sponsored Apostolic Bible Institute, for many years the largest ministerial training school in the United Pentecostal Church. Disagreement concerning some changes within the UPC caused Bro. Sabin and the Apostolic Bible Church to leave the United Pentecostal Church in the 1990s. The collection contains valuable audio and video recordings containing Sabin's teachings, as well as two debates between Oneness and Trinitarian theologians.
