Statement on Archival Language:

Biographical History

Morgan Scott Peck, the celebrated author of the best seller *The Road Less Traveled* and 14 other books, was born in New York City on May 22, 1936 as the younger of two sons of David W. Peck and his wife Elizabeth Saville. As the child of a very conservative and secularized Manhattan family, Scott Peck was raised to represent the highly educated elite and to become as successful professionally and socially as his father, a renowned lawyer and judge, who acquired prestige by heading the litigation department of a large New York City law firm.

At the age of 13, Scott Peck was sent to The Phillip Exeter Academy, a prestigious boarding school where David, Scott's older brother, had already succeeded. The school's elitist and competitive environment was a burden for young Scott Peck and two years later, after the summer break, he refused to go back. Diagnosed with depression, young Scott Peck was sent for a 5-week period in a psychiatric hospital for treatment. Later he would describe this incident as his first "emotional crisis" as well as his first experience with psychotherapy.

After his treatment, Scott Peck was enrolled at a co-ed, liberal, Quaker school, The Friends Seminary, an inclusive and cooperative environment where he felt accepted and adjusted well. It was also at The Friends Seminary, during a class on World Religion that Scott Peck first found himself attracted to spirituality. A few years later, at the age of 18, he would declare himself a Zen Buddhist.

Several influences nurtured young Scott Peck's passion for writing. Among them were his friendship with Carolyn Bryant, head of Bryant & Bryant, a leading publishing agency of the day; his friendship with John P. Marquand, a novelist who introduced Scott to the works of C.S. Lewis and others; and the reading of Steinbeck's *Grapes of Wrath* during an Exeter English class.

After graduating from Friends Seminary, Scott Peck enrolled at Middlebury College in Middlebury, Vermont. During his sophomore year he was stripped of most of his credits because he refused to attend the compulsory ROTC classes. He decided then to transfer to Harvard where his father was a member of the alumni council. At Harvard he was accepted, had his credits restored and in 1958 earned his Bachelor of Arts degree, magna cum laude. During his college years, Scott Peck had developed an interest in psychology and medicine so, after graduating from Harvard, he started his pre-med training at Columbia University.

During his year at Columbia, he met Lily Ho, a Chinese pre-med student and fellow classmate. One year later Scott and Lily were married in spite of the opposition encountered from both families. After six months, Scott started his medical training at Case Western Reserve University, graduating in 1964.

Because of an urgent need for financial independence from his father, who until that period had supported his studies, Scott Peck decided to enroll in the army in order to complete his medical training. While in the military, he completed a year of internship in Hawaii and 3 years of residency in San Francisco. He then served as a United States Army psychiatrist in Okinawa, Japan.

Scott Peck was strongly opposed to the Vietnam War, but because he could not leave the military he decided to work against the war from within. With this purpose in mind, he accepted a position as post-assistant chief of psychotherapy to the surgeon-general of the army, moving with his family to Washington DC in August 1970. During this time, Scott Peck did significant work on drug abuse, and in 1972, wrote a substantial report on the 1968 May Lai massacre containing recommendations for further research and an “in depth” study of previous military atrocities. Disappointed by having his recommendations rejected and his program on “drug abuse” misused, in 1972 Peck decided to resign, moving with his family to Litchfield County, Connecticut, where he opened a private practice and worked at a local clinic, hospital and jail.

In 1975, Scott Peck started working on *The Road Less Traveled*. According to his own description the words – “discipline, love, and grace” - came to him, as he felt called to write the book. In 1978, Simon & Schuster published the first 5,000 prints of the book. After a helpful review from Phyllis Theroux in the Washington Post, *The Road Less Traveled* made the newspaper’s best sellers list and later the nationwide US bestsellers list for 598 consecutive weeks. *The Road Less Traveled* deals with the connection between emotional and spiritual growth and is celebrated as one pioneer work on the integration of psychiatry and religion. The book has sold over 6 million copies in North America alone and has been translated into more than 20 languages.

While writing *The Road Less Traveled*, Scott Peck defined himself as someone in search of a more concrete spirituality. After writing the book, he became interested in reading the gospels and was compelled by the depiction of Jesus’ humanity. As Peck explained, he was driven by Christ’s humanity to later connect with his divinity. In March of 1980, at age of 43, Scott Peck publicly declared his faith in Jesus Christ at a non-denominational baptism ceremony.

Scott Peck has also published 14 other books, among them:

People of the Lie – the Hope for Healing Human Evil (October, 1983) published by Simon & Schuster, also deals with the integration between psychiatry and spirituality and acknowledges the role of evil in psychosis.

What Return Can I Make: Dimensions of the Christian Experience (December, 1985), published by Simon & Schuster, contains meditations written by Scott Peck and inspired for songs composed, played and sung for Sister Marilyn Von Waldner. Harpers republished this book in the fall of 1995, under the new title, *Gifts for the Journey: Treasures of the Christian Life, Meditations from the Road*.

Meditations from the Road (August, 1993), another of Scott Peck’s works on meditation and contemplative spirituality, is a compilation of thoughts from *The Road Less Traveled* published by Simon & Schuster.

The Different Drum: Community Making and Peace (June 1987), published by Simon & Schuster, presents Scott Peck’s practical views about community building and world peace in an innovative contribution to the behavioral sciences.

Denial of the Soul: Spiritual and Medical Perspectives in Euthanasia and Mortality (April, 1997) by Harmony Books (Crown) a book that deals with the medical, social, psychological and spiritual aspects of the disputed issue of euthanasia.

Peck's seventh book, *A World Waiting to Be Born: Civility Rediscovered* (March, 1993), a work on organizational behavior published by Bantam Books.

Golf and the Spirit: Lessons for the Journey (1999) illustrated by Christopher Peck and published by Harmony Books, applies principles of Golf to spiritual growth.

In Scott Peck's most recent book, *Glimpses of the Devil* (Free Press, 2004), the author reports the diagnosis, exorcism and follow up of two cases of demonic possession encountered during his psychiatric practice.

Peck also published 4 works of fiction: *A Bed By the Window: A Novel of Mystery and Redemption* (August, 1990), Peck's first novel, published by Bantam Books; *The Friendly Snowflake: A Fable of Faith, Love and Family* (October, 1992), Peck's first book for children, was illustrated by Christopher Peck and published by Turner Publishing, Inc.; *In Search of Stones: A Pilgrimage of Faith, Reason and Discovery*, a blend of autobiography, travel, spiritual meditation, history and Arthurian legend (1995); *In Heaven As On Earth: A Vision of the Afterlife* (Spring of 1996), Peck's second novel, a work of fiction that explores the mysteries of the afterlife.

Two books that summarize Peck's work are *Further along the Road Less Traveled* (October, 1993) published by Simon & Schuster, a collection of Peck's edited lectures from 1979 to 1993; and *The Road Less Traveled and beyond: Spiritual Growth in an Age of Anxiety* (January, 1997), also published by Simon & Schuster, a synthesis of all his work

Due to the overwhelming demand on his time, in 1983 Peck abandoned the practice of psychiatry and dedicated himself entirely to writing and lecturing. He also gave a number of interviews, wrote magazine articles and inspired the work of a great number of other authors.

After the success of *The Road Less Traveled*, a heavy bulk of correspondence started to come to Peck's address in Litchfield County, some from colleagues and editors and many from readers sharing their life stories and avid for advice and guidance. This enormous demand for attention led Peck to the conclusion that there was an extensive need for community all over the country. From the content of his reader's letters, Peck concluded that people where in need of someone to share intimacy and care. These were the ideas which led Peck, Lily and 9 others to establish in 1984 The Foundation for Community Encouragement (FCE), an educational non-profit organization whose mission was "to promote and teach principles of community". For almost 17 years the FCE dedicated itself to training selected leaders who could reach the needs for community by conducting workshops for the general public and for various organizations throughout the nation as well as internationally.

In acknowledgment of his work and dedication to the principles of community and peace, Scott Peck was the recipient of several honors and awards. Among them are the 1984 Kaleidoscope

Award for Peacemaking and the 1994 Temple of Peace Prize, in recognition for his community building work through FCE; The Faith Learning and Freedom Medal from Georgetown University (1996) and, in 1992 recognition by the American Psychiatric Association as a “distinguished psychiatrist lecturer.”

Cataloger’s Note

Due to their volume and significance, the documents related to The Foundation for Community Encouragement, earlier included among Scott Peck’s Papers, have been organized into a separate collection, “The Records of the Foundation for Community Encouragement.” – Cristina Demelo, Roger Robins, and Nancy Gower, circa 2007.

The PDF finding aid published on Archon lists 55 boxes, differentiating from a 2014 finding aid of approximately 60 boxes. For example: the Published PDF Finding Aid on Archon combine the Box 16 contents identified here as in Box 15. Subsequent Box numbers on the Published PDF Finding Aid reflect the alteration (Box 16, 17, 18, etc). The change is noted at each point within this Finding Aid. – Alyson Thomas, December 15, 2017

A collection review determined a need to address the content’s long-term storage condition and finding aid discrepancies. File folders were consolidated and stabilized in secure storage boxes. They maintain their pre-existing arrangement. Most of Peck’s published books (listed in a previous finding aid’s index as Boxes 4 – 11 and Box 13) had been added to the M. Scott Peck Special Collection. The removed published works are listed at the end of the finding aid with their respective locations. The finding aid has been updated to reflect the storage alterations of the remaining collection. – Esther Park, February 2025

Scope and Content

The M. Scott Peck Collection and Special Collection feature copies of Peck’s books in 25 translations and their published book reviews as well as magazine and newspaper articles. Copies of interviews include accounts of Scott Peck’s life and work. There are many of Peck’s additional published and unpublished writings, speeches, and thoughts. The collection includes Peck’s poetry; personal documents; personal and professional correspondence; honors and awards; and memorabilia.

Series I: Biography (Boxes 1-3)

Subseries 1: Articles about Scott Peck, 1985-2005 (Box 1)

Consists of articles about Peck's life and work. The material is arranged in alphabetic order by periodical title and the folders are labeled with bibliographic information for each article.

Subseries 2: Printed Interviews, 1983-2002 (Box 2)

Consists of periodicals and clippings containing public interviews given by Scott Peck. The material is arranged in alphabetic order by periodical title and the folders are labeled with bibliographic information for each article

Subseries 3: Education, 1951-1969 (Box 3)

Records track Scott Peck's education, beginning with high school at Phillips Exeter Academy, through Western Reserve University and his period of residency in the military, and culminating with his Harvard thesis: *Anxiety, Modern Science and the Epistemological Problem*.

Subseries 4: 60th Birthday, 1996 (Box 3)

This section documents Scott Peck's 60th birthday celebration, including video K7 with the recording of the ceremony.

Subseries 5: Personal miscellaneous, 1983-1993 (Box 3)

Miscellaneous personal documents such as passport and golf diary, as well as Dr. Peck's explanatory notes on the archives he placed at Fuller in 1994.

Subseries 6: Family and Friends, 1949-2003 (Box 3)

This section contains records and correspondence related to Peck's interactions with family and friends. It includes letters from Scott Peck to his parents (Elizabeth and David), mainly from his time at Phillips Exeter Academy. There are also documents portraying the significance of David Peck's career as lawyer and judge; a memorandum containing some biographical notes; and his obituary. The section also includes humorous letters from Scott Peck to his friends, Wally and Barbara Waltz.

Scott Peck's books in audiocassette, audio CD, and electronic format.

There is one box containing miscellaneous cartoons and satires of Scott Peck's works, especially *The Road Less Traveled*. The boxes' contents are organized in alphabetic order by periodical title. Each folder is labeled with the bibliographic information of the article.

This is a collection of published articles written by Scott Peck. The material is arranged in alphabetical order by periodical title and the folders are labeled with bibliographic information for each article.

Subseries 4: Speeches, 1990-2002 (Box 11)

Addresses given by Scott Peck on special occasions as well as written commentaries and opinions. The material is organized in chronological order.

Subseries 5: Poetry, 2001 (Box 12)

Scott Peck's poetry read and explained by the author. The material is recorded on 3 CDs accompanied by a notebook containing the transcripts. The collection is organized in chronological order.

Subseries 6: Contributions, 1979-2006 (Box 12-13)

Published items that include contributions, ideas or quotes from Scott Peck.

Series IV: Psychiatry and Religion (Box 14)

The section includes documents related to the establishment of a "Center of the Study of Deliverance." It also includes articles on Psychology and Religion and a phone conference between Scott Peck and Fuller Seminary students from the School of Psychology. The section includes Peck's address to the American Psychiatry Association and a standardized letter offering services as consultant in psychiatry and religion.

Series V: Social-political Views (Box 14)

Documents related to political and social matters, including a proposal for "The Community Presidency" with associated correspondence and comments and Scott Peck's political profile. It includes Peck's *The History of the Movement Toward National Sanity*.
