Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and

stereotypes that are not consistent with the current values and practices at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Within our finding aids, it is possible users may encounter language that is offensive or harmful. While some language included in finding aids was written by staff, other language originates from the people and organizations that created the material. For example, folder titles are often preserved from the creators. It is standard practice not to change them and, in some cases, it provides important context about the materials. When we find problematic language created by archivists and staff we strive to update it. When we find problematic language from the original creator we will transcribe as is to preserve the context of its creation.

Biographical History

Cadle Tabernacle (1921-1968) was a church built in Indianapolis, Indiana in 1921 by E. Howard Cadle, and named in honor of his mother, Loretta "Etta" Cadle. The building was built at the intersection of New Jersey and Ohio Streets across from Indianapolis City Hall. The building served as a center for evangelical programs and broadcasts on the Cincinnati, Ohio radio station WLW in the 1930s. With a seating capacity of 10,000 with a choir loft capacity of 1400, it was billed as the largest religious building in the world at the time.

E. Howard Cadle's radio program, *Nation's Prayer Period*, reached an estimated 30 million people between the 1930s and 1950s. Throughout its broadcasting history, coverage ranged across the Midwestern United States, Mexico, and Canada via 16-inch electrical transcriptions and short-wave radio stations. Monday through Saturday programs were 15 minutes long, and Sunday programs were 30 minutes long.

Scope and Content

The Cadle Tabernacle Audio Collection consists of 16-inch electrical transcriptions and compact discs (CDs) with audio transfers of the *Nations Family Prayer Period* radio broadcasts. The original airdates ranged from c. 1939 - c.1942. Read G. Burgan of RGB Digital created the compact discs, c. 2013.

Most discs are commercially pressed, though some are made from lacquer. Most discs play from the outside rim towards the center. The discs' conditions range from fair to poor. Some paper labels differ from the matrix numbers engraved in the discs. None of the lacquer discs have labels and no matrix numbers. Some labels also have notes indicating when the broadcasts aired at a particular radio station, but no indication of the original recording date.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged in three groups according to format: commercially pressed recordings, lacquer discs, and compact discs (CDs). The commercially pressed records are arranged with the matrix numbers as the primary reference. The lacquer discs are arranged with the description of the handwritten dates and contents if present. Programs with the prefix "W" are 15 minute weekday programs and discos with the prefix "S" are 30 minute Sunday programs.
