Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. Biographical History

Anthony DeGregorio (1905-1987) was born in Abruzzi, Italy in 1905. His parents immigrated to the United States in 1912 when he was six years old. He was a chef by profession and a man of many talents: a pianist, baritone soloist, and landscape painter. He specialized in sugar painting, using his own special blend of colored sugar, for which he won many awards.

He was a member of the Walnut Avenue Christian Church, Niagara Falls, New York where he served as a deacon and music director. He conducted sacred music concerts in order to raise funds for mission work.

He was also a collector of rare books and had the desire to write the history of the pioneers of the Italian Pentecostal movement in the United States. He started corresponding with the fathers of this movement from 1936 and collected their biographical and ministerial details. He gave this collection of biographies the title 'History of the Italian Movement.' The publication of the book is not known. The approximately 115 unpublished biographies and autobiographies (many written in Italian) of significant figures in Italian-American Pentecostalism offer rare glimpses into a people strongly opposed to "organized denominationalism." The documents shed light on the Italian-American experience and are useful for research on Italian and Brazilian-Italian Pentecostalism.

Scope and Content

The collection contains some biographical details on Anthony DeGregorio but primarily consists of his extensive correspondence with Italian Pentecostal pioneers and the material he collected and used in the writing of 'The Italian Christian Movement.' Included in his collection are draft histories of about 50 local Pentecostal congregations.
