Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and stereotypes that are not consistent with the current values and practices at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Within our finding aids, it is possible users may encounter language that is offensive or harmful. Biographical History

Dr. Arthur “Art” F. Glasser (September 10, 1914-December 8, 2009) was a missionary, missiologist, and Dean of the School of World Mission at Fuller Theological Seminary. He was born September 10, 1914. Glasser graduated from Cornell University in Civil Engineering in 1936. Then, he felt that God was calling him to full-time cross-cultural missionary service. Glasser studied at Moody Bible Institute and then at Faith Theological Seminary where he earned the Bachelor of Divinity degree. He earned a Master’s degree in Sacred Theology from Union Theological Seminary. After graduating in 1942, Glasser joined the Navy as a chaplain in the First Marine Division, which saw fierce fighting in the South Pacific in 1943 and 1944.

In 1945, Glasser and his wife Alice joined the China Inland Mission (CIM), and were a part of the first group of candidates accepted by CIM after World War II. In 1946, they began living in China and served as missionaries until 1951. In 1955, CIM appointed Glasser as its Assistant Home Director of CIM. In 1960, he became Home Director of the organization, by then renamed the Overseas Missionary Fellowship (OMF). During those years, Glasser was the editor of *China's Millions*, later called *East Asia's Millions*. In 1969, Glasser resigned his position with OMF to study for a year at Columbia University in New York.

In 1970, President David Allan Hubbard invited Glasser to join the faculty at Fuller Seminary and become the second Dean of the School of World Mission. He served as Dean from 1971 to 1980. Drawing from his lifelong passion for Jewish evangelization, Glasser founded the Judaic Studies Program in Fuller’s School of World Mission. He taught at Fuller from 1970 until his retirement in 1998. Glasser specialized in Biblical Theology of Mission and East Asian Studies. Glasser was recognized as Dean Emeritus from 1998-2009.

From the 1940s until the late 1960s, Glasser was also heavily involved with Erik Fife and others in the Urbana Missionary Conferences of the Foreign Missionary Fellowship of InterVarsity. Glasser served many years as Journal Editor and then President of the American Society of Missiology. Glasser helped pioneer the academic discipline of missiology and has had a broad and deep impact upon a generation of missiologists.

Scope and Content

The Glasser papers include Art Glasser's office files during his years as a Fuller faculty member, Dean of the School of World Mission, editor of *Missiology*, and Dean Emeritus. The papers are especially rich in the areas of ministry in France, Jewish missions and mission theory, including ecumenical missiology, as well as the ecumenical movement in general. Files include documents related to the following organizations: Overseas Missionary Fellowship, Institute of Japanese Studies; Latin American Mission; Scripture Union; World Presbyterian Missions; Zwemer Institute Board; Missionary Aviation Fellowship; Ambassadors for Christ; and Air Serv International.
