#### Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and stereotypes that are not consistent with the current values and practices at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Within our finding aids, it is possible users may encounter language that is offensive or harmful. ## **Biographical History**

Evelyn Jensen served as the Director of Academic Advising and Adjunct Assistant Professor of Women's Missiological Studies in Fuller Seminary's School of World Mission (SWM). Dr. Jensen taught courses related to the specific needs of American and international women involved in pre-service or mid-career cross-cultural ministries.

Jensen facilitated informal support groups, counseling, and classes to empower women to fulfill God's call for their lives. She was one of the first women to challenge and insist that the School of World Mission faculty fully recognize the women who contributed to the development of God's mission enterprise throughout history. She, along with four other women in 1986 and 1987, planned and developed the first course for SWM on women's concerns in cross-cultural mission, which she also taught.

In addition, Jensen served as the president of the Southern California chapter of Christians for Biblical Equality.

# **Scope and Content**

The Papers of Evelyn Jensen consists of Dr. Evelyn Jensen's academic course material and book manuscripts. Topics focus on doctrinal theology, gender roles, and women in missions and ministry. Records also include Jensen's travel notes and journal. Dates range from 1980-1994. Content is written in the English language. A Special Collection of published works supplements the archival collection.
