Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and stereotypes that are not consistent with the current values and practices at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Within our finding aids, it is possible users may encounter language that is offensive or harmful. While some language included in finding aids was written by staff, other language originates from the people and organizations that created the material. For example, folder titles are often preserved from the creators. It is standard practice not to change them and, in some cases, it provides important context about the materials. When we find problematic language created by archivists and staff we strive to update it. When we find problematic language from the original creator we will transcribe as is to preserve the context of its creation.

Biographical History

Librarian, archivist, bibliographer and historian, Charles E. Jones (1932 -) received his education at the Bethany-Peniel College in Oklahoma and the Universities of Michigan (M.A.L.S.) and Wisconsin (M.S. and Ph.D.). His Ph.D. dissertation, published as *Perfectionist Persuasion: The Holiness Movement and American Methodism, 1867–1936* (1974), provides background for understanding the sociological and ecclesiological reasons for the rise of the Holiness movement.

Jones has worked as a librarian and archivist at Nazarene Theological Seminary, Park College, the University of Michigan, and Brown University and as a professor of history at Houghton College. In February 2006, a symposium was held at Fuller Theological Seminary in celebration of his scholarly achievement and his gift to the seminary.

Scope and Content

The Charles Edwin Jones Collection at Fuller Theological Seminary includes both printed and archival materials. The printed collection is an extensive corpus of materials documenting the Holiness, Pentecostal and Charismatic movements, as well as the contexts in which these traditions have developed. The Jones archives include his research notes, correspondence, rare ephemera related to the subjects of his research. His collection contains significant runs of Holiness periodicals both on paper and on film.

Series Description

Series I: Personal, 1950-2010 (Boxes 1-24)

Series I contains documents related to the academic and personal life of Charles E. Jones. There are materials from his careers in education (including course notes), and as librarian, bibliographer and author.

The Series also includes material related to the churches where Jones worshipped and ministered. It includes records relevant to the associated denominations, Reformed Episcopal and Episcopal. Subseries “Writings” includes Jones’ manuscripts of his published and unpublished articles. There is also family correspondence.

Series II: Correspondence (Boxes 25-26)

Series II consists of Jones's professional and private correspondence. The bulk of the correspondence is related to bibliographical work. It also includes copies of letters related to his job search, his correspondence with Senators and Beverly Jones's personal correspondence.

Series III: Research, 1859-2008 (Boxes 27-110)

Series III consists of Charles E. Jones's collected files of research notes and primary source materials gathered for his writings, especially for his bibliographies. The section is especially strong in documentation of the Holiness movement, including the Church of God (Holiness) and the Church of the Nazarene.

Subseries 1: Books (Box 27)

A small collection of books. Most of Charles Jones' books have been cataloged as the Jones Special Collection.

Subseries 2: Booklets, 1859-1956 (Boxes 28-37)
