**Statement on Archival Language:**

## Biographical History

Dr. Glen Harold Stassen (February 29, 1936 – April 26, 2014) was a Southern Baptist theologian who championed social-justice in the 1980s Evangelical community; advanced nuclear disarmament talks; and co-authored the widely used Christian ethics textbook, *Kingdom Ethics: Following Jesus in Contemporary Contexts* (2003). Dr. Stassen served as the Smedes Professor of Christian Ethics at Fuller Theological Seminary, and founder of the Just Peacemaking Institute.

Dr. Stassen was born on February 29, 1936 in Minnesota. His particular passion included contributing to peace and justice initiatives within communities. Glen Stassen was a civil rights organizer in the 1960s, and marched with Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. In the 1970s, Dr. Stassen was a leader in the movement for open housing laws in Kentucky.

Stassen attended University of Virginia (BA in Physics, 1957), Union Theological Seminary (BD, 1963), and Duke University (PhD, 1967). He was also a visiting scholar at Harvard University, Duke University, Columbia University, and the University of Heidelberg. While in Germany, Dr. Stassen worked as a liaison between the Nuclear Weapons Freeze Campaign in the United States and European peace groups. He took on a leadership role in the disarmament movement as co-chairman of the freeze campaign's strategy committee. His activism highlighted practical approaches to social justice and world peace, outlining a grass-roots activism strategy to reduce military spending and promote citizen voices in international conflict resolution.

Stassen taught at Kentucky Southern College (1964-1969) and Berea College (1972-1976). He joined the faculty of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky as a professor of Christian ethics in 1976. He left SBTS in 1996. Stassen joined the faculty at Fuller Theological Seminary in 1997 as a professor of Christian ethics.

Dr. Stassen is recognized for his academic work regarding peace-making and ethics. He was the co-author of a textbook widely used to teach Christian ethics, *Kingdom Ethics: Following Jesus in Contemporary Contexts* (2003). Other notable works include *Just Peacemaking: The New Paradigm for Ethics of Peace and War* (coedited with David Gushee, 2008, 3<sup>rd</sup> ed.), *Peace Action: Past, Present, and Future* (coedited, 2007), *Authentic Faith: Bonhoeffer's Ethics in Context* (edited, 2007), *Living the Sermon on the Mount* (2006), *Authentic Transformation: A New Vision of Christ and Culture* (1996, with D.M. Yeager and John Howard Yoder), and *Just Peacemaking: Transforming Initiatives for Justice and Peace* (1992). Many of these have been translated in several languages.

Glen Stassen finished his teaching career as the Smedes Professor of Christian Ethics at Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, CA. During his professorship, he created a Just Peacemaking Institute to further his vision for alternatives to war.

## Scope and Content

The Papers of Glen Harold Stassen contain materials related to Stassen's academic work a teacher from the 1960s-2000s as well as his peacemaking activism efforts. Research topics

included Christian ethicist H.R. Niebuhr, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, Christian discipleship, Christian ethics, and Just Peacemaking. The collection also has files from Stassen's work with Peace Action, formerly known as SANE and the Nuclear Weapons Freeze Campaign. Formats include course binders, meeting minutes, syllabi, overhead transparencies, lecture notes, newspaper clippings, and book drafts. Inclusive dates range from 1941-2011.
