Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and stereotypes that are not consistent with the current values and practices at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Within our finding aids, it is possible users may encounter language that is offensive or harmful. While some language included in finding aids was written by staff, other language originates from the people and organizations that created the material. For example, folder titles are often preserved from the creators. It is standard practice not to change them and, in some cases, it provides important context about the materials. When we find problematic language created by archivists and staff we strive to update it. When we find problematic language from the original creator we will transcribe as is to preserve the context of its creation.

Biographical History

Robert Willard Pierce (b. October 8, 1914 - d. September 6, 1978) founded World Vision International in 1950 and Samaritan's Purse in 1970. "Dr. Bob" is also known for founding the globally recognized Korean Orphans Choir (later renamed "Korean Children's Choir"). Their first world tour started in 1961, which included performances for Fuller Theological Seminary, U.S. President Eisenhower, India's Prime Minister Nehru, The Ed Sullivan Show, and Carnegie Hall. Many government leaders and heads of state honored Dr. Pierce's work and "Christ-like compassion-in-action." On three separate occasions, the president of South Korea presented him with the highest honor South Korea can bestow upon a foreigner.

Converted at an early age, Dr. Pierce felt called to serve God until his death in The City of Hope Medical Center. Dr. Pierce studied for the ministry at Pasadena Nazarene College in California. His work in producing the first Christian films earned him a Litt.D. from Northwestern College in Minneapolis. He married Lorraine Johnson, and had three daughters: Sharon, Marilee, and Robin.

In 1940, Dr. Pierce was ordained by the Baptist church and became involved with Youth for Christ (YFC). He participated in YFC's evangelical rallies in China until 1950. His exposure to the China and Korea's wartime conditions, poverty, and needs of war orphans led to his founding of World Vision International in 1950.

Scope and Content

The Robert Pierce Collection primarily contains transcripts of Pierce's personal oral history interviews (1977-1978) and those he conducted with World Vision missionaries in person or via radio broadcast (1950s-1970s). Tapes are interspersed throughout the collection.

The records were used as resources for the 1983 publication, *Bob Pierce: This One Thing I Do* by Franklin Graham and Jeanette Lockerbie (Waco, TX: Word Books). A copy of the rough draft and associated correspondence is included.

"Thank you" letters sent to Wayfarers Ministries are included at the end of the collection. Betty Ann Wagner, one of Pierce's initial co-workers at Samaritan's Purse, was the primary correspondent. Dates range from 1981-1994.

Many transcripts were copied and arranged by topic. In some cases, the same transcript may be found filed under multiple subjects. Those folders are arranged according to Wagner's original organization.
