Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. Biographical History

Dr. Lewis Benedictus Smedes (August 20, 1921 - December 19, 2002), speaker and best-selling author, taught Christian Ethics and Theology at Fuller Theological Seminary.

Smedes studied at Calvin College (1947, B.A.), Calvin Theological Seminary (1950, B.D), and the Free University of Amsterdam (1953, Th.D.). He was educated and ordained in the Reformed Christian (Calvinist) tradition, and worked as a parish minister in Paterson, New Jersey. Smedes taught at the Free University in Amsterdam from 1968-1969 and Calvin College from 1957-1970. He married Doris Dekker in 1948.

Smedes was a visiting professor in the philosophy of religion at Fuller from 1968 to 1970. Smedes joined as a full-time faculty member in 1970. During his time at Fuller, Smedes served on a number of faculty committees, including as chairperson for the task force responsible to evaluate the MC510 Signs and Wonders course (1980s). In 1990, Smedes accepted the position of Chair for the Integration of Psychology and Theology in Fuller's School of Psychology, where he served until retiring in 1995. At that time, the Lewis B. Smedes Chair of Christian Ethics was established in his honor in the School of Theology. Smedes was on the editorial staff for *The Reformed Journal* (magazine ran from 1951-1990, Eerdmans). Smedes also served on the Bioethics Committee of the Huntington Memorial Hospital in Pasadena, California.

Smedes was a sought-after speaker and author. Topics touched on various aspects of Christian living and morality, including social justice, sexuality, forgiveness, grace, guilt, shame, and hope. Fuller Seminary published a memorial issue for Dr. Smedes in the *Fuller Focus*, Summer 2003.
