Statement on Archival Language:

The David Allan Hubbard Library aims to describe archival materials in a way that is respectful to all communities who use, create, and are represented in our collections. However, the nature of historical materials is such that some material may represent positions, language, values, and

Biographical History

Charles Peter Wagner (b. Aug.15, 1930 – d. Oct. 21, 2016) was born in New York City, NY. His childhood consisted of several moves across 4 states due to his father's struggle for work. He attended the College of Agriculture at Rutgers University (class of 1952) expecting to go into a career in dairy farming. After meeting his wife Doris, Wagner accepted Christ and dedicated his life to being a missionary.

The Wagners prepared for missionary service by moving to California. Dr. Wagner attended Fuller Seminary (Master of Divinity, 1955) and Mrs. Wagner attended Biola College. The couple went to Bolivia as missionaries, where Dr. Wagner trained pastors at a Bible institute. In 1966-1967, Wagner returned to Fuller Seminary for the M.A. program and studied under Donald McGavran in the Graduate School of World Mission (SWM). McGavran invited Dr. Wagner to teach as an adjunct professor in 1968, and later to join the faculty.

Dr. Wagner's initial areas of concentration were missions and church growth. Wagner came from a very conservative background, considering himself anti-Pentecostal. His attitude changed after he began studying Latin American Pentecostalism (due to the rapidly growing Pentecostal churches in Latin America). He became a main articulator of the incorporation of spiritual power into evangelicalism. Dr. Wagner initiated the instruction and practice of the power dimension of the Great Commission to Fuller Seminary.

Dr. Wagner served as a missionary in Bolivia from 1956-1971 under the South American Mission and Andes Evangelical Mission (now SIM International). He then served as Professor of Church Growth at FTS School of World Mission (SWM) from 1971-2001. He authored 80 books, was the founding president of Global Harvest Ministries from 1993-2011, and was founder of the Wagner Leadership Institute (WLI, now "Wagner University") established in 1998. He also founded the Reformation Prayer Network (originally named "Spiritual Warfare Network") in 1991, International Coalition of Apostles (ICA) in 1999, Eagles Vision Apostolic Team, and the Hamilton Group.

Scope and Content

The C. Peter Wagner collection includes Wagner's teaching material for Fuller Theological Seminary courses, records relating to various publications, correspondence with organizations and events, and personal files. Articles discussing the creation and popularity of the Fuller Seminary course "MC510: Signs and Wonders," which Wagner co-taught with John Wimber (1981-1985), are within the collection.

Bound volumes include Wagner's writings during his missionary service in South America and academic analyses of his work. Inclusive dates range from 1930-2016. Subjects focus on church growth, missions, and the Apostolic Movement.

Series Description

Series I: Course Materials & Teaching Notes, 1979-2000 (Boxes 1-12)

The series contains lecture notes, syllabi, class records, and feedback for various courses taught by Wagner at Fuller Theological Seminary. Some administrative reports and Faculty Senate minutes are included.

The series also includes primary research materials related to Wagner's "Liberation Theology Catalog." Wagner gave the "Liberation Theology Catalog" materials to Fuller Seminary's

McAlister Library in 1972. Wagner stated that it was arguably the most complete collection of Liberation Theology primary sources up to that date.

Series II: Writings of C. Peter Wagner, 1956-2014 (Boxes 13-18, 32-35)

The series contains materials and correspondence related to written works by C. Peter Wagner. It includes drafts of Wagner's books "Dominion!", "Let's Laugh", and "Second Apostolic Age" (title later revised to "Changing Church"), and his memoir "Wrestling with Alligators." Bound volumes contain original and photocopied versions of his published articles. Materials are in English and Spanish languages. Dates range from the 1950s-2016. Bibliographies are available upon request. The series also includes student dissertations written about Wagner's work.

Publication Records (Boxes 17-18) are restricted until 2050. Publication records are between Wagner and his publishing companies.

Series III: Organizations and Events, 1978-2013 (Boxes 19-28, 35)

The series contains correspondence, reports, and notes related to Wagner's involvement with apostolic and professional organizations and events. Organizations include Global Harvest Ministries (G.H.M), International Coalition Apostles (ICA), Lausanne Committee for World Evangelization (LCWE), and Wagner Leadership Institute (WLI).

The series includes newsletters and administrative notes related to the Sunday School class "120 Fellowship" at Lake Avenue Congregational Church, Pasadena CA.

Series IV: Dialogues, Personal, and General Files, 1963-2007 (Boxes 28-31, 35)

The series includes prayer letters and personal prophecies given to Wagner. It also includes files related to John Wimber, Columbia International University, Spiritual warfare, and the apostolic movement.

Series V: Audio-Visual Materials, 1978-2011 (Boxes 36-37)

The series includes audiocassette copies of Wagner's lectures and personal audio recordings. Fuller Seminary, the Fuller Evangelistic Association (1993), and the National Symposium on the Postdenominational Church (1996, 2011) produced the lecture tapes.

Wagner stated that this was arguably the most complete collection of Liberation Theology primary sources up to that date. At one point, Wagner considered doing his PhD dissertation at USC on the subject.
