Abstract: Photographs documenting GLBT Historical Society events, exhibitions, staff, and board members from the organization's founding in 1985 until 2008, Also included are numerous photographic prints and slides that were donated individually or as small sets. Events, people, and topics represented in these small donations include Gay Freedom Day, Lesbian/Gay Freedom Day, and Pride events; Folsom Street Fair; Harvey Milk; Sylvester; drag performers; protests; the leather scene; LGBT sports teams; and private parties.

This is an artificial collection assembled by staff and volunteers of the GLBT Historical Society.

Processing Information:

Reprocessed by Devin McGeehan Muchmore in September 2023.

The collection consists of boxes originally labeled “PH 4.1” under an old, inhouse classification scheme. The boxes were labeled “GLHS Photos;” “GLHS Slides;” “Origin/Photographer Unknown;” “Photographer Identified;” and “Impersonators.” These categories were retained as series in the reprocessed collection, with GLHS Photos and Impersonators retitled “GLBT Historical Society organizational records” and “Performers,” respectively, to better reflect their content. Most folders and folder titles have been retained. Photos and negatives were sleeved as needed.

This finding aid uses terminology for LGBTQ people that was in current use at the time of its creation. Descriptive language for queer identities evolves quickly and some of these terms may now be dated or even offensive. Finding aids are themselves historical documents; they reflect the moment in which they were written and often reflect the terms that subjects used for themselves. Scope and Content:

This collection was likely first brought together by GLBT Historical Society staff and volunteers in the 1990s. Photographic prints, negatives and slides created by GLBT Historical Society board members and volunteers document the organization’s activities and collections from its founding in 1985 through 2008, including selected exhibitions and public events; board members and personnel; photos of its offices; and photographic surrogates of collection materials that were used for exhibits and slide shows. Some materials refer to the organization by earlier names, including the San Francisco Bay Area Gay/Lesbian Historical Society and the Gay and Lesbian Historical Society of Northern California (GLHS). The collection also includes numerous photographic prints and slides that were donated individually or as small sets. Previous GLBT Historical Society processors organized these by subject, event, or photographer. Events, people, and topics represented include Gay Freedom Day, Lesbian/Gay Freedom Day, and Pride events; Folsom Street Fair; Harvey Milk; Sylvester; drag performers; protests; the leather scene; LGBT sports teams; and private parties.
