Cookbook	1897	Cookbook: Issued by The Ladies' Aid Society of the First Congregational Church of Ventura, California. Belonged to Alice Day Bartlett, acquired by her in 1898-notation on fly leaf in her handwriting. Used by her daughter Mable Gould.
Black cookbook	1910	Pleasant Valley Cook Book: A Cook Book of Tried Recipe, Given by the Ladies of Camarillo, California and Vicinity, and Their Friends, For the Benefit of the Pleasant Valley Baptist Church, Camarillo, California. Compiled by Mrs. E.W. Mecum. Note: Belonged to Katie Weaver, life long triend and housekeeper of the Charles Bartlett family.
Commercial cookbooks	1917-1960	Published by food distributors to promote the use of a particular brand. These are samples of that reflect agricultural products grown and marketed in the County. Includes California Home catsup, Del Monte tomatoes and other produce, Calavo avocados, and Sunkist organges.
Commercial cookbooks	1913-1923	These cookbooks are more like pamphlets. Includes "Salads and salad dressing by the World Famous Chefs"; "Made Dishes: Salads and Savories with French's Cream Salad Mustard"; Jell-O recipes and menus.
