Notes on Language:

Throughout this collection, users may notice the usage of terms as related to identity (Mexican-American) and gender (Chicano/Chicana) they are not used to seeing. To maintain historical accuracy and alignment with the era the collection represents, we used the language present in the materials to describe them. However, language, terminology and culture all change and we acknowledge that many scholars, researchers and librarians now use Chicanx as a more relevant, gender inclusive term. The term also references a connection to Indigeneity, decolonial consciousness, inclusion of genders outside the Western gender binary imposed through colonialism, and trans-nationality.

Richard Santillán Biography:

Dr. Richard Santillán has been a longtime activist and advocate for the Mexican-American community of California. As a professor, Dr. Santillán has researched and documented the participation of Hispanics in the American political system and was considered one of the foremost experts in this field – writing extensively on the electoral process, redistricting and reapportionment in California and how it has affected the Mexican-American community. He taught Chicano Studies for over 45 years in the California State University system, 37 years as Professor Emeritus at California State Polytechnic University, Pomona.

Dr. Santillán was born in East Los Angeles in 1947 and coming of age during the civil rights, anti-war and various other social movements, Dr. Santillán became active in the Chicano Movement first as a student in United Mexican-American Students (UMAS) and the Movimiento Estudiantil Chicano de Aztlan (MEChA) and then with the United Farm Workers movement. Since 1969, he has been published in books, journals, and newspapers, and has appeared on countless television and radio programs documenting and discussing the long and rich history of the Mexican American people in the United States. As a community activist his focuses center on issues of minority voting rights, voter registration, reapportionment, political campaigns, at-large district elections as well as other political and cultural work.

In 1981 as director of the Chicano Reapportionment Project, Rose Institute of State and Local Government, Claremont, California, he organized a series of conferences which culminated in the creation of Californios for Fair Representation, one of the best organized groups addressing reapportionment as it affected the Chicano community in the state of California.

Dr. Santillán received his BA degree from Los Angeles State College, his MA from San Fernando Valley State College, and his Doctoral degree in 1978 in American Politics and U.S. Foreign Policy from the Claremont Graduate School.

Dr. Richard Santillán currently lives in Southern California and writes primarily about Mexican-Americans and baseball.

Scope and Content of Collection

The Richard and Gloria Santillán Collection – Papers, Documents, Clippings, Newsletters and Journals contains the personal papers and research files of Dr. Richard Santillán, a longtime professor, activist and advocate for the Mexican-American community of California. This collection's topical coverage is extensive, as well as its depth. Represented within are materials related to:

- Richard Santillán's scholarly work – including drafts and published articles and manuscripts; correspondence; materials stemming from leadership and engagement in academic associations and conferences.
- Organizational files collected by Richard Santillán. The approximately 50 organizations included in this collection represent a broad spectrum of Mexican-American and Latino interests including political, social, legal, civic, business, education, etc. This includes news clippings, correspondence, pamphlets, flyers, meeting notes, government documents and reports.
- Research files containing information on a wide range of topics, mostly related to the Mexican-American and Latino communities. Amongst a multitude of topics, there is extensive coverage of legal rulings and court cases relevant to the Mexican-American community, redistricting and reapportionment, voting rights and the 1980 census, and the 1982 California gubernatorial campaign.
- Pre-arranged articles, reports and other writings not authored by Richard Santillán.
- A major focus on the Chicano movement, political organizing and advocacy. Within this topical focus are materials documenting the farmworker struggles for labor rights, police violence against the Chicano community and La Raza Unida political party. Materials included are primarily newspaper clippings, flyers, monographs and meeting minutes, conference reports and campaign materials from Raza Unida Party candidates.
- Richard Santillán's professional and professorial career – with a major focus on his tenure grievance at Cal State Los Angeles. Also included are administrative materials from his professorial appointments and professional work as well as correspondence, documents, reports, teaching materials and articles.
- Topical focuses on the formation of the city of East Los Angeles, Education, Immigration, and the MEChA (Movimiento Estudiantil Chicano de Aztlán) and UMAS (United Mexican American Students) organizations.
- Periodicals and news clippings including volumes of clippings produced by COMEXAZ (Comite de Mexico Y Aztlan); periodicals from across the United States focusing on Chicano life, culture, politics, news, etc. and extensive news clippings.
- Oversized, miscellaneous and unarranged materials.

Series Descriptions

Series 1: Manuscripts, 1970 – 1991

Carton 1 Arranged Chronologically

Contains manuscripts, articles, drafts and other writings authored by Richard Santillán – some handwritten, some containing edits and comments.

Series 2: COMEXAZ, 1973 – 1980

Carton 2 – 3 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials from Oakland-based, national media watch group COMEXAZ (Comite de Mexico Y Aztlan). Comprised mostly of students, COMEXAZ monitored five national newspapers a day and collected any clippings that dealt with the Mexican American community. Clippings were then bound and sold to Chicano organizations at a yearly subscription rate.

Series 3: Conference Papers / Materials, 1972 – 1995

Carton 4 – 5 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials related to academic associations and conferences organized or attended by Richard Santillán. Includes correspondence; conference announcements, materials and agendas; miscellaneous conference papers (not authored by Richard Santillán); and conference programs.

Series 4: Organizational Files, 1965 – 1998

Carton 6 – 8 Arranged Alphabetically

Contains materials from organizations focusing on the Chicano community; electoral politics and political representation; education/Chicano Studies; law; government/legislatorial policy work and community/grassroots organizing.

Series 5: Research Files, n.d.

Carton 9 – 22 Arranged Alphabetically

Contains news clippings, academic reports, pamphlets, flyers and correspondence collected by Richard Santillán organized into topical research files. The topics cover a wide range of subjects – the largest concentration being on the law, electoral politics, redistricting and reapportionment in California, Tom Bradley's 1982 gubernatorial campaign and the Chicano experience primarily in Los Angeles and Southern California.

Series 6: Pre-arranged Scholarly Articles* / Miscellaneous, n.d.

Carton 23 – 27 Assorted Arrangement

Contains (pre-arranged) photocopies of scholarly articles on various topics and miscellaneous reference items.

*Pre-arranged refers to arrangement that occurred before 2019 processing.

Series 7: The Chicano Movement / La Raza Unida Party, 1951 – 1995

Subseries 7.1: Chicano Movement, 1951 – 1995

Carton 28 – 29 Arranged Alphabetically

Contains materials related to the Chicano Movement, specifically in the Southwest United States. The two largest focuses are on the California Farmworker Struggle and extensive coverage of police violence against the Chicano community from across the Southwest US, particularly Denver, Colorado. The Farmworker materials is primarily comprised of news clippings, but also includes other formats documenting the struggle for labor rights for almost a decade. Additional coverage includes information folders on important political organizations, perspectives and events in the Chicano movement.

Subseries 7.2: La Raza Unida Party, 1966 – 1978

Carton 30 – 31 Arranged Alphabetically

Contains materials related to La Raza Unida Party (LRUP) chapters and activities, mainly focused on California. Includes meeting minutes and notes from California statewide conventions, campaign materials from local California LRUP candidates, chapter periodicals and materials from national conventions and other states.

Series 8: Evaluations and Reports, 1966 – 1985

Subseries 8.1: Student Evaluations, 1972 – 1978

Carton 32 Assorted Arrangement

Contains student evaluations of Professor Richard Santillán.

Subseries 8.2: Research Reports, 1966 – 1985

Carton 33 – 34 Assorted Arrangement

Contains assorted reports on various topics.

Subseries 8.3: United States Commission on Civil Rights Reports, 1967 – 1981

Carton 35 – 37 Arranged Chronologically

Contains reports published by the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights – a bipartisan, independent commission of the United States federal government charged with investigating, reporting on, and making recommendations concerning civil rights issues in the United States.

Contains assorted correspondence.

Contains personal items, biographies and resumes, cards, certificates and handwritten notes.

Subseries 9.3 Testimonies and Court Records, 1982 – 1985

Carton 39 Folders 6 – 11 Arranged Chronologically

Contains transcripts from Richard Santillán's testimonies on election reform and Chicano participation in the electoral process as well as court records from cases in which Richard Santillán was a plaintiff or expert witness.

Subseries 9.4: California State University Los Angeles, 1970 – 1991

Carton 39 Folders 12 – 16 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials from Richard Santillán's time at Cal State Los Angeles including teaching materials, and other assorted items.

Subseries 9.5: California State Polytechnic University Pomona, 1981 – 1995

Carton 40 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials from Richard Santillán's time at Cal Poly Pomona including course syllabi, readers and curricula; correspondence; announcements and flyers; copies of the Poly Post (periodical); student papers and assorted reports, memorandum, newsletters, and agendas.

Subseries 9.6: Richard Santillán Tenure Defense, 1974 – 1979

Carton 41 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials related to Richard Santillán's defense committee, formed after he was denied tenure and faced termination at Cal State Los Angeles. Includes support letters, petitions, university memoranda, news coverage of the struggle, flyers, correspondence and materials produced by the Defense Committee.

Subseries 9.7: The Rose Institute, 1979 – 1991

Carton 42 Arranged Chronologically

Contains documents and materials created by the Rose Institute. Under the direction of Richard Santillán, the Rose Institute became involved in the study of Hispanic demographics and political development with the Chicano/Hispanic Project, which published reports and held conferences related to California's redistricting and its effect on Hispanics and Latinos as well as strategies for Latino empowerment and educational reform. The Rose Institute also maintained other projects including the Latino Atlas and Latino Political Project / The Journal of Hispanic Political Studies.

Subseries 9.8: Project Participar, 1983 – 1984

Carton 43 Folders 1 - 8 Arranged Chronologically

Contains reports and other miscellaneous materials from Project Participar – a statewide coalition of over 50 organizations designed to increase the participation of Hispanics in all aspects of civic responsibility. The goal was to register 250,000 Latino voters in California by Nov. 1984.

Subseries 9.9: California State University System, 1969 – 1997

Carton 43 Folders 9 – 20 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials related to the state-wide California higher education system.

Subseries 10.1: Immigration, 1970 – 1989

Carton 44 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials related to the broad topic of immigration. The majority of items are news-clippings, drawn from local, regional and national news sources; but the carton also includes flyers, pamphlets, press releases and statements; and legislative and government documents.

Subseries 10.2: Movimiento Estudiantil Chicax de Aztlán (MEChA) /

United Mexican American Students (UMAS), 1968 – 1984

Carton 45 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials related to the MEChA and UMAS student organizations. Includes periodicals, meeting notes, general historical information and background on chapters across California.

Subseries 10.3: East Los Angeles, 1969 – 1981

Carton 46 Arranged Chronologically

Contains materials related to East Los Angeles in California. The majority of the items are focused on the 1974 effort to incorporate East Los Angeles as its own city – with additional materials on local community groups, East Los Angeles College and library and general news clippings.

Subseries 10.4: Education, 1965 – 1994

Carton 47 – 49 Arranged Alphabetically

Contains materials related to the broad topic of education related to the Chicano community.

Series 11: Chicano Movement and Community Periodicals, 1968 – 1984

Carton 50 – 57 Arranged Alphabetically

Contains periodicals from across the United States focusing on Chicano life, culture, politics, news, etc. The majority of the periodicals originate in California or Texas between 1970 and 1980.

Contains news clippings from various newspapers.
