8. ABSTRACT:

SHARE (Salvadoran Humanitarian Aid, Research and Education) Foundation was founded as a faith-based organization in 1981. The collection documents the role that SHARE Foundation played in organizing the interfaith community during the 12 year Civil War in El Salvador (1981-1992), working closely with US Sanctuary Congregations and leaders, the Catholic church in the United States in close collaboration with the Archdiocese in San Salvador, the Lutheran Church in El Salvador and DIACONIA and Catholic Charities in Honduras. The foundation continues to support social justice and sustainable development for the people of El Salvador and Honduras.

9. BIOGRAPHICAL DESCRIPTION:

The Salvadoran Humanitarian Aid, Research and Education Foundation (SHARE) in Washington, DC, and New El Salvador Today (NEST) founded in 1981. SHARE publicized Salvadoran refugees' treatment by the Honduran Armed forces and the militarization of the camps. The organization raised funds to support the people of El Salvador during various crisis including several earthquakes and the challenges of refugees returning to the country.

The civil war in El Salvador ran from 1979 until peace was obtained in 1992. The conflict is considered the last one of the Cold War. The United States government feared that El Salvador would become a communist state and provided training and munitions, which were often used against noncombatants.

Over 75,000 noncombatants were killed and an additional 8,000 “disappeared.” Religious leaders and helpers were assassinated or brutally killed: Archbishop Óscar Romero, shot while saying Mass in 1980; numerous religious helpers including four Catholic women from America were raped and killed in 1980; and six Jesuit priests and their housekeepers were killed at the University of Central America in 1989.

Following the peace agreement, life continued to be difficult for those who remained and for those who returned from the camps and the countries that they emigrated to.

SHARE provided assistance in the form of coordinating help from religious leaders and other organizations, fund raising for assistance with the refugee camp and their return to their home, additional help for emergency issues from earthquakes and hurricanes health care, and help for health and education.

1981	Salvadoran Humanitarian Aid, Research and Education Foundation (SHARE Foundation) founded in Washington, DC. New El Salvador Today (NEST) founded in the San Francisco Bay Area (later combined with SHARE).
1982	SHARE Foundation begins work with Salvadoran refugees in the UN-sponsored refugee camps in Mesa Grande, Honduras.
1983	SHARE Board of Directors conducts fact finding visits to El Salvador as guests of the Archdiocese of San Salvador, visiting displaced communities taking refuge in local parishes. Opens dialogue with the Lutheran Church in El Salvador and the broader ecumenical community.
1984	SHARE publicizes refugees’ treatment by the Honduran Armed forces and the militarization of the camps.
1986	SHARE testifies before the U.S. House of Representatives Western Hemispheric Affairs Sub Committee on behalf of Archbishop John R. Quinn about the situation of human rights violations in El Salvador. SHARE and NEST mobilize political support and \$100,000 in financial support for the victims of the October earthquake. SHARE launches the Sister Parish Program to create sistering relationships between U.S. parishes and parishes in San Salvador with a high internal refugee population.
1986	SHARE raises \$100,000 in response to the devastating October earthquake and recruits the Dean of the Catholic University of America’s School of Social Work to travel to El Salvador.
1987	SHARE launches the Going Home Campaign, together with the Interfaith Office on Accompaniment, a national campaign that generates political, moral and financial support for 10,000 refugees who seek to repatriate their homeland from Honduras to their home communities in El Salvador.

1988	SHARE provides moral, political, and financial support to refugees returning home from Mesa Grande and ongoing humanitarian support to displaced communities in El Salvador.
1989	Six Jesuits and two women are assassinated by the army at the University of Central America. SHARE and NEST increase advocacy to stop US military aid and negotiate resolution to the war. SHARE organizes a delegation of U.S. Lutheran and Episcopalian Bishops and theologians to accompany exiled Lutheran Bishop Medardo Gomez on his return to El Salvador to celebrate Epiphany and call for an end of the repression.
1990	Following a military attack on Corral de Piedra in Chalatenango, killing children, SHARE organizes an emergency delegation. The Going Home Campaign reaches one million-dollar goal from the Seeds of Hope Campaign.
1990	SHARE sponsors a delegation of Catholic Bishops to observe the first year anniversary of the martyrdom of the Jesuits and deliver the annual SHARE Human Rights award to the University of Central America "José Simeon Cañas," the Jesuit University.
1992	On January 16, the Peace Accords are signed in Chapultepec, Mexico. In October, SHARE and NEST merge and become "SHARE Foundation: Building a New El Salvador Today."
1992-1994	Major advocacy focus is on the completion of the land transfer program outlined in the Peace Accords.
1995-1997	Tecoluca becomes SHARE's target area for rural development support. Debt forgiveness of the land transfer debt acquired.
1998-1999	On October 31, Hurricane Mitch devastates the Lower Lempa Communities. SHARE expands target area work further into Zacatecoluca, La Paz, and Lower Lempa area of Usulután.
2000	Twentieth anniversary of Monsignor Oscar Romero's death and memorial delegations observed. Over 60 women religious attend a SHARE delegation in honor of the 20th anniversary of the martyrdom of the four US church women.
2001	As earthquakes ravage El Salvador, SHARE mobilizes support and funds projects with long-term development vision.
2002	SHARE hosts 20th Anniversary celebrations in El Salvador and the United States culminating in a 3-day celebration in DC.

2003	SHARE continues its transition from the Lower Lempa to the new area in Chalchuapa and Atiquizaya, in the west part of the country.
2004	SHARE accompanies the observation of the presidential electoral process with a delegation of 112 people.
2005	SHARE sponsors over 140 delegates to visit El Salvador to celebrate the 25th Anniversary of the Martyrdom of Monsignor Romero. SHARE advocates the fight against the Central American Free Trade Agreement (CAFTA).
2006	SHARE celebrates its twenty-fifth anniversary. SHARE begins work with with 100 women as part of an adult women's literacy project in Jiquilisco, Chalchuapa and Atiquizaya. SHARE also begins its support of communities threatened by metallic mining.
2007	SHARE joins the National Working Group Against Metallic Mining and the Archbishop of San Salvador in the effort to halt mining in El Salvador which risks the water supply.
2008	SHARE launches the "Seeds of Hope Campaign" to help provide food security for families affected by drought and flooding as a result of climate change.
2009	SHARE recruits and trains over 160 international election observers, including lawyers, students, labor leaders and religious and lay people who travel to El Salvador to support fair presidential elections.
2010	SHARE brings a delegation of 45 people to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the martyrdom of Monseñor Romero in March, and in December brings a delegation of 50 people to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the martyrdom of the Four North American Churchwomen.
2011	SHARE Celebrates its 30th Anniversary.
2015	SHARE co-sponsors the 35th anniversary celebration of the lives of the 4 US church women with 120 women religious and lay leaders who travel to El Salvador.
2016	SHARE celebrates its thirty-fifth anniversary, partnering with U.S. Sister Cities, SALVAIDE and CRIPDES to host an international solidarity gathering, which looks back on over 30 years of solidarity between the peoples of El Salvador and the U.S.
2018	SHARE Organizes the largest contingent (outside of El Salvador) to attend the canonization of Archbishop Oscar Romero in Rome, Italy.
2020	40th anniversary celebration of US Church Women – virtual delegation with the Leadership Conference of Women Religious (LCWR) to El Salvador.

Series 6, Embroidery

Content: The embroidered textiles made by Salvadoran refugees tell the story of their displacement, their lives in the Mesa Grande refugee camp in Honduras, and their return to El Salvador. Upon hearing that Father Gerardo Pöter, a German Dominican priest who worked in the camp from 1983-1984, would be touring the United States and discussing the refugee situation, women in the camp embroidered these cloths to assist him in telling their story. Upon the end of Father Pöter's trip, he gave the embroideries to SHARE, which became part of their archival record. 31 items.
