### Abstract

A system of horse- or mule-drawn street cars was established in downtown San Diego in 1886. In 1887 electric street car service was begun, serving a more widespread area including Old Town and University Heights. The San Diego Electric Railway Company (SDER) was founded in 1891 by John D. Spreckels. Spreckels purchased several existing transit companies and converted them all to electric operation. In the 1920s and 1930s the rail lines began to be replaced by motor buses. In 1948, under new ownership, the name of the San Diego Electric Railway was changed to the San Diego Transit Company. The last rail service was discontinued in 1949, making San Diego the first major city in California to convert to an all-bus system.

### Scope and Content

This collection contains the business papers, contracts, financial reports, and correspondences of the SDER.
