Historical Note:

Environmental Horticultural Science (formerly Ornamental Horticulture) and Crop Science merged in 2002 creating the Environmental and Crop Science Department within the College of Agriculture, Food, and Environmental Sciences (CAFES). The department specializes in the three primary areas: Environmental Horticultural Science, Fruit and Crop Science, and Plant Protection Science.

Horticulture has been a part of the agriculture curriculum at Cal Poly since its founding in 1901 as a technical vocational school. Coursework included horticulture, floriculture, and greenhouse propagation. By 1939 the program, then titled Landscape Gardening, included courses such as General Nursery Practice, Elements of Design, and Landscaping of City and County Property. The program included flower cutting, landscape design, and greenhouse production. Paul Ecke Jr., of Ecke Ranch known for greenhouse poinsettia production, was an early supporter of the department and served on the advisory council until 2002. In the 1940-41 school year the department was reorganized as Ornamental Horticulture and the first Bachelor of Science degrees were awarded in 1942. By the 1990s the department had expanded to Environmental Horticulture Science which later merged with Crop Science.

Scope and Content:

The collection contains documents, photographs, photographic slides, and other materials related to the development and administration of the Horticulture and Crop Science Department at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo including the formerly titled Ornamental Horticulture Department. Records include the working papers of Professor and former Interim Head of Environmental Horticultural Science Virginia Walter (retired) reflecting department advancement, operations, and curriculum. Records of the Pi Alpha Xi honorary society Upsilon Chapter at Cal Poly which was established in 1975 include charter applications and photographic images of chapter events. Records also include travel documentation, ranking documentation, and photographs of the Floral Design Team and program. Photographic images and slides reflect course content, department activities, student work, floral and plant exhibits and projects, and greenhouse projects.

Arrangement:

The collection is arranged in four series. Original organization of the records has been preserved where possible. Materials may have been reorganized or rehoused for preservation and access purposes.

Series I Documents and photographs related to the Ornamental Horticulture department between 1958-2013.

Series II Documents and photographs created and collected by Professor Virginia R. Walter who joined the faculty in 1974 and retired in 2017.

Series III Records related to Pi Alpha Xi Upsilon Chapter chartered September 1, 1975.

Series IV Photographs and photographic image slides created and collected between 1958 – 2009.
