**Appendix A: Bibliography.** Printed sources, dissertations, theses, and unpublished papers – mainly relating to Jos Plateau and its inhabitants; neighboring areas including Bauchi emirate; ironworking in Nigeria, Africa and other parts of the world; mining and iron ore; forestry, deforestation, charcoal making; archaeology, archaeometallurgy and analysis of ore, slag, and smelted iron; economic history, trade and exchange, slavery, and slave trade; ethnography; geography; geology; historiography and oral history; linguistics. Archival/primary sources are listed separately.

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## **Appendix B: “National Archives of Nigeria: Kaduna (NAK) – List of Files Pertaining to the Jos Plateau and Its Peoples,” by David C. Tambo, 7 July 2013.**

The richest source of archival material relating to the period of British rule in northern Nigeria are the government records deposited at the National Archives in Kaduna. Jos Plateau-related materials begin with the 1902 occupation of Bauchi. Until the creation of Plateau Province in 1926, the Jos Plateau was part of Bauchi Province. Within the colonial administrative hierarchy, each province in northern Nigeria contained several divisions which further were divided into districts. In some cases independent districts were carved out, which were directly subordinate to the provincial administration. Officials in the divisions and districts submitted reports to the Resident of the province and the Resident in turn used the material from the various district and division reports to compile his provincial report which was forwarded to the Northern Nigeria regional offices. Reports on expeditions, patrols and tours contain the most detailed accounts available on initial British contact with Plateau groups.

During the early years of colonial rule, British officials also collected a wide assortment of historical, ethnographic, and linguistic material to provide a basis for administrative decisions concerning the selection of local 'traditional' officials and the determination of political boundaries. To provide a reservoir of economic information for tax purposes, they researched such topics as market prices for basic commodities, land tenure patterns, crop yields and house-hold composition. The findings, along with recommendations for tax rates, appeared in assessment and reassessment reports.

Additional information of historical interest oftentimes is found in the 'pagan' administration and reorganisation reports describing British efforts to uncover forms of political authority on the Plateau which could be superimposed or adapted in various local situations to meet colonial administrative needs. District notebooks and intelligence reports, for the most part initiated in the 1920s and 1930s, provide further material of historical interest.

The following list of files was compiled during visits to NAK, as part of Ph.D. fieldwork for the University of Wisconsin-Madison, conducted 1975-1976. The focus of the research was economic history of ethnic groups on the Jos Plateau and adjacent areas in the latter nineteenth century and early twentieth century, especially relating to iron working and trade in iron items. Gunn (Harold D.) Collection. Yale University Library, Manuscripts and Archives (MS 1586). The Harold D. Gunn Collection contains verbatim and near verbatim copies of provincial, division, and district files from various northern Nigeria provinces, including Bauchi and Jos Provinces. Included are intelligence and other reports, memoranda, district notebooks, place name gazetteers, research materials, and maps, c. 1908-1950, collected by Gunn, mainly while he was in Nigeria, 1949-1952, as a research anthropologist for the International African Institute. Tambo (David C) Nigerian History Collection. University of California Santa Barbara, Special Collections (Bernath MSS 383). The collection mainly contains research files from 1975-1976 fieldwork on the Jos Plateau of Nigeria, including copies of this list and other lists of archival and published sources relating to the Jos Plateau, oral history translations/transcripts, maps, photographs, and samples of iron ore, slag, furnace walls, tuyeres, smelted iron, and finished iron items. Also, some material from time as a Peace Corps volunteer in Bauchi, Nigeria, 1968-1970, mainly photographs and artifacts such as early Nigerian coins and leather goods.
