Organizational History

The National Association of Black and White Men Together (NABWMT) is a gay multiracial, multicultural, political and social organization founded in 1980. The first chapter was formed in San Francisco by Mike Smith as a consciousness-raising and support group for gay men involved in or interested in multiracial relationships. Groups were soon established across the United States. Early chapters included Boston, Chicago, Kansas City and New York. The first national convention was held in 1981 in San Francisco. The organization is a collective nationwide network of affiliated and developing chapters across the United States that identify themselves as Black and White Men Together (BWMT), Men of All Colors Together (MACT), or People of All Colors Together (PACT) in keeping with the cultural dynamics of their respective areas. As of 2011, there were over 30 local chapters. The organization is committed to fostering respect, honesty, and communication among people of different races and cultural backgrounds and welcomes people of all racial, ethnic and cultural backgrounds. NABWMT promotes supportive environments wherein racial and cultural barriers can be overcome and the goal of human equality realized. activities as a means of dealing with the racism, sexism, homophobia, HIV/AIDS discrimination and other inequities in their communities and in their lives. NABWMT holds social functions, discussion groups, and an annual conference. (from http://nabwmt.org/aboutus.html, accessed in January 2012)

Scope and Content of Collection

This collection documents the history and political, social and cultural work of the National Association of Black and White Men Together (NABWMT). Original order and folder titles were maintained and reflect NABWMT's internal file arrangement. The collection includes organizational records; Board materials; internal and external correspondence and memos; financial records; writings, including studies, reports and speeches; materials related to newsletters and other publications; convention programs and planning materials; a wide variety of representative documents from local and regional chapters; subject files; audio and videotapes from conventions; oral history project interviews; photographs; and artifacts.

Highlights include important formative documents; meeting minutes; materials related to antiracism work; audiotapes of speeches by Audre Lorde, Manning Marable and Perry Watkins; interview with Bayard Rustin, and papers documenting the separation of NABWMT and the National Task Force on AIDS Prevention (NTFAP). NTFAP originated as a program of NABWMT and was preceded by the AIDS education and support work carried out by local chapters across the country.

Significant numbers of national, regional and chapter newsletters have been transferred to the GLBT Historical Society Periodical Collection. Researchers should also consult the Black and Men Together San Francisco Bay Area records (1991-04), Men of All Colors Together San Francisco Bay Area records (2000-64) and National Task Force on AIDS records (2000-59). There is a great deal of overlap in all these collections.
