Abstract: The collection includes material related to Eileen Lee and Marilyn Abbink's documentary, *Women of Gold*, which focuses on Asian and Pacific Islander women who participated in the 1990 Gay Games in Vancouver, Canada. Materials include VHS and U-Matic copies of the film; photographic prints, negatives, and contact sheets; film screening ephemera; and printed materials and ephemera from Gay Games 1990 and Gay Games 1994.

This finding aid uses terminology for LGBTQ people that was in current use at the time of its creation. Descriptive language for queer identities evolves quickly and some of these terms may now be dated or even offensive. Finding aids are themselves historical documents; they reflect the moment in which they were written and often reflect the terms that subjects used for themselves. Biographical Note:

Eileen Lee was born in New York state and grew up in Taiwan, Singapore, and the Philippines. She attended San Francisco State University, graduating with a degree in broadcasting arts. She and Marilyn Abbink co-founded Lee/Abbink Productions to produce *Women of Gold* in 1990. In a May 1991 article in *Outlines* in which Lee and Abbink discuss the video, Lee commented on motivations for making the film: “I want other Asian lesbians to not feel like they’re alone.”

Scope and Content:

This collection contains materials related to Eileen Lee and Marilyn Abbink’s *Women of Gold*, a documentary about Asian and Pacific Islander women participating in Celebration ‘90: Gay Games III and Cultural Festival in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada.
