**Abstract:** Timothy (Tim) Wong (1957-2020) was a photographer who extensively documented gay and leather events, primarily in the 1990s-2000s San Francisco Bay Area. The collection consists primarily of Wong's photographic output, including prints, contact sheets, and negatives depicting AIDS Emergency Fund events; Bare Chest Calendar contests and events; the Castro Street Fair; Dore Alley Fair; Mr. Drummer contests; Folsom Street Fair; International Mr. Leather contests; gay rodeos; San Francisco Pride; San Jose Pride; and events at SF Eagle, among others. Also included are a smaller number of contest files related to Wong's work as a tallymaster, and materials originally belonging to Marcus Hernandez, better known as Mister Marcus, who was a close friend of Wong's.

## **Acquisition Information:**

Legal ownership and copyright were transferred to the GLBT Historical Society by Thomas Wong in September 2021. The physical collection was donated to the GLBT Historical Society by Bill Weaver in October 2021.

#### **Processing Information:**

Collection processed and finding aid created by Ash Waltz and Devin McGeehan Muchmore in 2024 with funding provided by the National Historical Publications & Records Commission.

At the time of donation, the collection was stored in 37, non-archival bankers' boxes. The materials were organized by format and/or theme, with the labels "Prints," "Loose Negatives," "Mr. Marcus," "Albums," "Large Prints/Contact Sheets," "Loose Photos," and "Contest Files" roughly identifying the boxes' contents. This received arrangement has largely been retained in the collection's series, with "Prints" being retitled "Developer Envelopes" to better convey their form. All non-archival boxes were replaced. Additional processing information can be found in series and subseries specific notes.

This finding aid uses terminology for LGBTQ people that was in current use at the time of its creation. Descriptive language for queer identities evolves quickly and some of these terms may now be dated or even offensive. Finding aids are themselves historical documents; they reflect the moment in which they were written and often reflect the terms that subjects used for themselves. #### **Biographical Note:**

Timothy (Tim) Albert Wong (April 28, 1957-March 17, 2020) was born and grew up in Oakland, California. He had five siblings, including a twin brother, Thomas. Wong attended Oakland's St. Anthony's Catholic School and Bishop O'Dowd High School, and earned a B.S. in Electrical Engineering from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. Upon graduating college, he took a job at Hewlett Packard, where he worked for 30 years.

Wong was an avid photographer, extensively documenting San Francisco's gay and leather scenes in the 1990s and 2000s. A number of his photographs were featured in the *Bay Area Reporter*, an LGBT community newspaper in San Francisco. Throughout this period, Wong was particularly active in Bare Chest Calendar related activities, taking thousands of photos to document the events. Beyond the extensive collection of event photos, he also took professional portraits of contest winners. Wong was also a participant in the gay leather scene, serving as

tallymaster for several leather title competitions and maintaining a friendship with the leather journalist Marcus Hernandez (Mister Marcus).

Wong died at Stanford Hospital at the age of 62.

**Scope and Content:** This collection comprises primarily photographs taken by Timothy Wong at gay and leather events in the 1990s and 2000s. A voluminous quantity of 4x6-inch prints in retail film developer envelopes and smaller numbers of photo albums, large prints, contact sheets, photographic negatives and positives, loose photos, and slides all cover similar ground, extensively documenting AIDS Emergency Fund events; Bare Chest Calendar contests and events; the Castro Street Fair; Dore Alley Fair; Mr. Drummer contests; Folsom Street Fair; International Mr. Leather contests; gay rodeos; San Francisco Pride; San Jose Pride; SF Eagle events; and other leather events and contests (including some women's/dyke leather contests). In addition to Wong's photographs, the collection contains records related to Wong's participation in leather competitions as a tallymaster and judge, including ballots, contestant forms, and ephemera from several months of the Bare Chest competitions for 2002, 1996 and 1998 International Mr. Leather, 2001-2006 Mr. San Francisco Leather, and 2002 and 2005 Ms. World Leather. Also included are photographs, a binder-scrapbook, computer media, and personal ephemera belonging to and created by Marcus Hernandez, the leather columnist for the Bay Area Reporter and a close friend of Wong's. The collection includes little direct documentation of Wong himself. A small number of photographs depict Wong and his family, and several awards document his role as tallymaster for title competitions.

**Arrangement:** This collection is organized into nine series: Series I: Personal files, circa 1990-2000s; Series II: Developer Envelopes, 1983-2003; Series III: Photo albums, circa 1990s; Series IV: Large prints and contact sheets, circa 1990s; Series V: Loose photos, 1970-2008; Series VI: Negatives and positives, circa 1990-2000; Series VII: Slides, circa 1981-1990s; Series VIII: Contest files; and Series IX: Marcus Hernandez papers, circa 1950s-2006.

### Series II: Developer Envelopes, 1983-2003

**Physical Description:** 30.5 linear feet (about 30.5 cartons)

Scope and Content: This series consists of photographic prints and associated negatives held in retail film developer envelopes—mostly from Costco. The photos were taken by Wong at a variety of Bay Area events. The majority of photos document the local gay men's leather scene, including contests, parties, and fundraisers. Significant collections of photos document AIDS Emergency Fund events; Bare Chest Calendar contests and events; the Castro Street Fair; Dore Alley; Mr. Drummer leather contests; Folsom Street Fair; International Mr. Leather contests; Rodeos; San Francisco Pride; San Jose Pride; SF Eagle events; and other leather events and contests (including some women's/dyke leather contests). Other photos document Wong's life with friends and family, travels, and attendance at parties, gay bars, fundraisers and community events.

Arrangement: This series has been organized into 13 subseries. Subseries A: AIDS Emergency Fund, circa 1990s-2000; Subseries B: Bare Chest, circa 1990s-2003; Subseries C: Castro Street Fair, circa 1990s-1999; Subseries D: Dore Alley Fair, 1991-2002; Subseries E: Drummer events, circa 1990s-2000; Subseries F: Folsom Street Fair, 1990-2001; Subseries G: International Mr. Leather, 1992-1998; Subseries H: Rodeos, circa 1990s-2001; Subseries I: San Francisco Pride, 1983-2002; Subseries J: San Jose Pride, 1990-2002; Subseries K: SF Eagle, circa 1990s-1998; Subseries L: Other Leather events, circa 1990s-2002; and Subseries M: Other events, 1989-2010 Processing Information: To facilitate access, the processing archivists organized this series into 13 subseries. Specific families of related events—such as Bare Chest events and gay rodeos—with ten or more files were formed into subseries.

Three kinds of information appear in the file-level Scope and Content notes within this series: an envelope count, unique identifiers for select envelopes, and annotations from those selected envelopes.

Many of the developer envelopes arrived bundled into groupings with rubber bands. Most bundles included envelopes containing photos depicting the same event. The processing archivists kept the rubber banded groups together in folders to preserve the structure of the received order, with each grouping appearing as a single file/line in the finding aid. Individual events often span multiple bundles, and some bundles span multiple physical folders. Envelopes that were not bundled into groupings were usually placed into folders individually. Envelope counts in the file-level Scope and Content notes in this series indicate the number of envelopes that were originally held together in a rubber-banded bundle.

Most of the envelopes feature annotations by Wong that provide added context to the photos. Event names and dates have been recorded as file titles and dates. Where multiple events are depicted in a single roll of film, the processing archivists recorded both events in the title, with a "/" in between. Additional annotations were recorded only when they provided information not otherwise represented in the folder title, using an identifier from the corresponding envelope to distinguish among them. The envelopes themselves feature several distinct numbering schemes (e.g. 1 of 6) and lettering schemes (e.g. BX, CX, HM) that Wong likely used to organize his collection. These schemes were referenced when recording envelope annotations. In instances where multiple labeling schemes were used for a single envelope/series, the processing archivists only selected one scheme for reference, with priority given to numbering schemes.

Thus, the Scope and Content for the file "AIDS Emergency Fund Banquet, 1999" is recorded as follows:

Scope and Content: 8 envelopes; 10 of 15: Desserts; 2 of 15: Keith Truitt, Bob Ross

Eight envelopes of photos documenting the 1999 AIDS Emergency Fund banquet were bundled together. However, only two of the envelopes featured additional annotations. On an envelope Wong numbered "10 of 15," he wrote "Desserts," in addition to the name of the event.

## Subseries A: AIDS Emergency Fund, circa 1990s-2000

**Physical Description:** 0.5 linear feet (about 0.5 cartons)

**Scope and Content:** Photos depicting AIDS Emergency Fund (AEF) banquets and other events affiliated with the organization. AEF was established in 1982 as a non-profit organization that provided critical financial assistance to eligible persons with AIDS and disabling AIDS-related conditions. AEF was also the recipient of Bare Chest Calendar fundraising revenue.

# Subseries B: Bare Chest, circa 1990s-2003

**Physical Description:** 173 folders (about 7.5 linear feet)

**Scope and Content:** Photos depicting events, contests and outings relating to the Bare Chest Calendar. The Bare Chest Calendar is a fundraising project that supports the AIDS Emergency Fund. Calendar models for each month of the year were chosen at contests, many of which were held at the SF Eagle. Beyond documenting the contests, this subseries also includes photographs from fundraising auctions, Bare Chest Men appearances at Pride events, and portraits of contest winners taken by Wong.

Bare Chest Calendar contests were typically held the year before the calendar was to be released. Competitions for the 1998 calendar, for example, were held in 1997. This is reflected in the file dates. Dates in the title indicate the calendar for which men were competing. Dates appearing after the comma indicate the date the photographs were taken.

### Series IX: Marcus Hernandez papers, circa 1950s-2006

Known more commonly as Mister Marcus from his weekly *Bay Area Reporter* (*B.A.R.*) column on leather culture and events both in San Francisco and around the United States, he wrote for *B.A.R.* for 38 years, from 1971 to 2009, while also contributing articles and photographs to *Drummer* Magazine, *The Leather Journal*, and many other publications.

Hernandez, whose first name was Gilbert, was born in Los Angeles on March 22, 1932. He attended the University of California, Los Angeles but departed before completing his degree. In 1952, Hernandez married Marian Givens, with whom he had four sons. They met, according to Givens, while working at the Pentagon in Washington D.C. A few years after their marriage, Hernandez joined the U.S. Air Force and served in both the United States and Europe until he was honorably discharged in 1960. He separated from his wife that same year and continued to live in Los Angeles until 1968 when a friend suggested moving north to San Francisco (according to one of his sons, Curt, 1968 was also the year that Hernandez came out as a gay man).

In his first decade living in San Francisco, Hernandez managed a variety of leather bars and began writing for the Bay Area Reporter, for which he would be honored numerous times as Outstanding Columnist in the public voting for San Francisco's Cable Car Awards (Mister Marcus would eventually be taken out of contention and placed in that category's Hall of Fame). Additionally, Hernandez also served briefly as the appointment secretary for then Mayor Joseph Alioto of San Francisco.

During the 1980s, Hernandez took up photography, attending and photographing leather contests in San Francisco and, eventually, all over the United States, Canada, and Europe. He was frequently a judge at many of these contests and spent much of his time traveling across the country to attend and/or judge an estimated 250 contests during his years as a columnist, including various Mr. Leather, Mr. Drummer, and International Mr. Leather contests (for which he became the Judge Emeritus for life). He also played a major role in the production of the Bare Chest Calendar.

In addition to his involvement in the leather community, Hernandez was actively part of the Imperial Court of San Francisco, one of the largest and oldest LGBT organizations in the world. In 1972, Hernandez became the first Emperor of the Imperial Court, or Emperor I After Norton. During his reign, he established the Spoon Awards which were presented to individuals in 20 different categories for continuously "stirring the pot". He continued his involvement with the Imperial Court throughout his life, judging contests for many years.

In the summer of 2009, Hernandez was hospitalized when his health worsened; he passed away a few months after due to complications from diabetes and arteriosclerosis on October 9, 2009 in Pacifica, California. He was 77. (This Biographical Note was copied from the finding aid for the Marcus Hernandez collection, 2011-03)

**Scope and Content:** This series contains materials received in a box labeled "Mr. Marcus," who was a close friend of Tim Wong. Included are photos from Hernandez's early adulthood; photographs by Hernandez and others, spanning from the 1970s-2002, documenting gay, leather, and HIV/AIDs-related events and figures; and a small cache of personal ephemera, correspondence, binder-scrapbook, and commercially-released videos. The series also includes a box of computer storage media. The labels indicate they contain photos and text documents stemming from Hernandez's personal and professional leather activities, including as leather columnist for the *Bay Area Reporter*, but the media remain unsurveyed as of October 2024. **Arrangement:** This series is arranged into four Subseries: Personal files, circa 1950s-2006; Photos by Marcus Hernandez, circa 1970s-2002; Photos by others, circa 1970s-2001; and Computer storage media, circa 2000-2003.

**Processing Information:** The materials in this series were received in a box labeled "Mr. Marcus." The box contained piled folders, envelopes, a binder, loose photographs, film developer envelopes, VHS and DVDs, a plastic box containing zip disks and 3.5" floppy disks, and additional loose computer media and ephemera. Photos held in developer envelopes have been kept together. Loose photos were sorted based on common characteristics (i.e. photos were clearly from the same event, of the same person(s), and/or were thematically similar) or annotations provided on the back of the photos.
